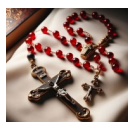

PASTOR'S COLUMN

During this month of October dedicated to the Holy Rosary, we continue to consider how the Rosary orients our hearts to Christ.

During the month of Mary back in 2003, Pope Benedict XVI gathered in the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore to pray the Rosary with the faithful. He said: "Today, together we confirm that the Holy Rosary is not a pious practice banished to the past, like prayers of other times thought of with nostalgia. Without a doubt, this is one of the most eloquent signs of love...for Jesus and his Mother, Mary. In the current world, so dispersive, this prayer helps to put Christ at the center, as the Virgin did, who meditated within all that was said about her Son, and also what he did and said. When reciting the Rosary, the important and meaningful moments of salvation history are relived. The various steps of Christ's mission are traced. With Mary, the heart is oriented toward the mystery of Jesus. Christ is put at the center of our life, of our time, of our city, through the contemplation and meditation of his holy mysteries of joy, light, sorrow and glory...The Rosary, when it is prayed in an authentic way, not mechanical and superficial but profoundly, it brings, in fact, peace and reconciliation."

The Holy Father's words resonate deeply for us on this feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

In our fast-paced and distracted world, where our attention is scattered and our hearts are often divided, the Rosary is so powerful at orienting our restless hearts toward what truly matters: **Jesus Christ**.

Mary, more than anyone, knew how to keep Christ at the center of her life. The Gospel tells us she "*kept all these things, pondering them in her heart.*" She didn't just admire her Son from afar; she meditated upon every word and gesture and mystery of His life. Through the Rosary, we ponder with Mary the great mysteries of Christ's life, death, and Resurrection.

Through the Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious, and Luminous mysteries, Mother Mary gently takes us by the hand and says, "*look at Him,*" "*ponder Him,*" "*understand Him,*" "*love Him,*" "*imitate Him.*"

Pope Benedict was so right when he said the Rosary brings peace, for not only does the Rosary teach us to slow down, to listen, to breathe—it centers us on Christ who is our peace. So much division would be healed and conflict resolved if more of us took up the Rosary devoutly.

During this month of the Rosary, let us take up the Rosary often, that our hearts may be oriented more fully to the mystery of Jesus, that our world, our parish, and our hearts may be filled with His peace, for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.
