PASTOR'S COLUMN

This last Sunday, October 19, 2025, before a joyful crowd of 70,000 in St. Peter's Square, Pope Leo XIV proclaimed seven new saints for the Church. "Today we have before us seven witnesses," the Holy Father said, "who with God's grace kept the lamp of faith burning. They themselves became lamps capable of spreading the light of Christ."

Among these radiant new saints are figures from every corner of the world. Venezuela rejoiced as its first saints were canonized: **St. José Gregorio Hernández Cisneros**, the beloved "doctor of the poor," who offered his medical skills in humble service to the sick; and **St. María del Carmen Rendiles Martínez**, a religious sister born without her left arm who founded the Servants of Jesus in Caracas, teaching that our limitations can become instruments of grace.

St. Peter To Rot, a lay catechist from Papua New Guinea, became his nation's first saint. He courageously defended Christian marriage during the Japanese occupation of World War II and was martyred for his faith. **St. Ignatius Maloyan**, an Armenian Catholic archbishop, was executed during the Armenian genocide after refusing to convert to Islam.

Two Italian women also joined the canonized: **St. Vincenza Maria Poloni**, foundress of the Sisters of Mercy of Verona, who risked her life caring for cholera victims in 1836; and **St. Maria Troncatti**, a Salesian missionary affectionately known as *Madrecita*, who spent 44 years among the Shuar people of Ecuador's Amazon, serving as nurse, surgeon, and catechist.

One of the most remarkable stories among these new saints belongs to **St. Bartolo Longo**. Born in 1841, Longo was a bright young lawyer who drifted from the faith and fell into the darkness of occultism and even Satanic ritual. His life was one of despair—until, through the prayers of loved ones and the mercy of Christ, he experienced a radical conversion. Embracing Our Lady as his advocate, he dedicated his life to promoting the Rosary as the sure path back to God. He built the great Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary in Pompeii, transforming a region of poverty and superstition into a center of devotion and charity. "Whoever spreads the Rosary," he said, "is saved!"

During this month of the Rosary, we do well to take his message to heart, and to ask Our Lady and each of these newly canonized saints to help us to respond to God's call to holiness. Through their intercession, may we too keep our lamps of faith burning brightly for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

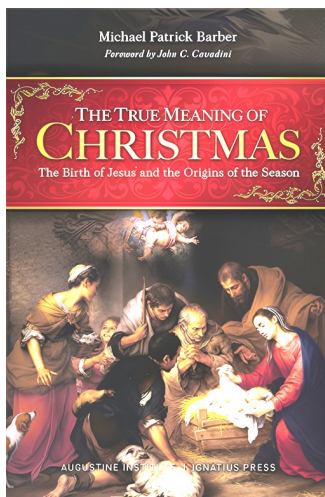

pray for them.

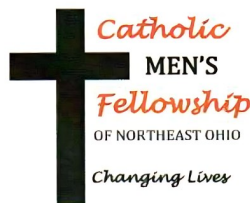

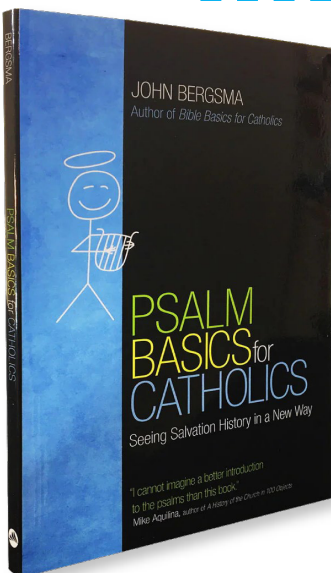

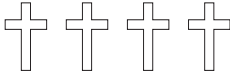
