

#### **PASTOR'S COLUMN**

This week our nation celebrates Thanksgiving. One might say our entire Christian vocation is one of continuous thanksgiving. "In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus" (1 Thess 5:18).

We have a beautiful dialogue regarding thanksgiving in every celebration of the Mass: the priest says, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God," the people reply, "It is right and just." The priest then adds, "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, Holy Father." We continue to hear about thanksgiving throughout the Mass, particularly at the highest point of the Mass, when we recall how at the Last Supper, our Lord took bread and wine, and gave thanks to God before transforming them into His body and blood.

Thanksgiving marks every celebration of the Mass because thanksgiving is meant to mark every day of our lives. A part of every single day should be carved out for giving thanksgiving to God for the blessings that fill your life, whether you can come to Church or not. Without intentional acts of thanksgiving, we begin to take the blessings of God for granted. Thanksgiving produces joy in us. Joy is born from grateful hearts. Looking for more joy? Then practice more thanksgiving!

Catechism says, "Thanksgiving characterizes the prayer of the Church which, in celebrating the Eucharist, reveals and becomes more fully what she is. Indeed, in the work of salvation, Christ sets creation free from sin and death to consecrate it anew and make it return to the Father, for his glory. The thanksgiving of the members of the Body participates in that of their Head. (CCC 2637)"

When we give thanks to God, we are united to Jesus who was ever-thankful to His Father.

The saints, too, encourage us to give thanks.

St. Gianna Beretta Molla: "The secret of happiness is to live moment by moment and to thank God for all that He, in His goodness, sends to us day after day."

St. Thérèse of Lisieux: "Jesus does not demand great actions from us, but simply surrender and gratitude."

St. Josemaría Escrivá: "Get used to lifting your heart to God, in acts of thanksgiving, many times a day."

St. John Vianney: "Believe and adore. Believe that Jesus Christ is in this sacrament as truly as He was nine months in the womb of Mary, as really as He was nailed to the Cross. Adore in humility and gratitude."

May thanksgiving mark our lives, bring us joy, and witness to the world of our faith in Christ Jesus for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.
