

PASTOR'S COLUMN

In an Advent homily from 2009, Pope Benedict explained the meaning of the Latin word adventus, from which the term Advent derives. He explained how *adventus* can be translated as presence, arrival, or coming. He continues, "In the language of the ancient world [adventus] was a technical term used to indicate the arrival of an official or the visit of the king or emperor to a province. However, it could also mean the coming of the divinity that emerges from concealment to manifest himself forcefully or that was celebrated as being present in worship."

"Advent, this powerful liturgical season that we are beginning, invites us to pause in silence to understand a presence. It is an invitation to understand that the individual events of the day are hints that God is giving us signs of the attention He has for each one of us. How often does God give us a glimpse of His love! To keep, as it were, an 'interior journal' of this love would be a beautiful and salutary task for our life! Advent invites and stimulates us to contemplate the Lord present. Should not the certainty of His presence help us see the world with different eyes? Should it not help us to consider the whole of our life as a 'visit,' as a way in which He can come to us and become close to us in every situation?

"Advent becomes an opportunity to reawaken within ourselves the true meaning of waiting, returning to the heart of our faith which is the mystery of Christ, the Messiah who was expected for long centuries and was born in poverty, in Bethlehem. In coming among us, He brought us and continues to offer us the gift of His love and His salvation." (HOMILY OF HIS HOLINESS BENEDICT XVI, 28 November 2009, www.vatican.va) I encourage you to take many moments this Advent "to pause in silence," as Pope Benedict taught, to ponder those "hints" of God's presence in your lives. Advent is a meditative season. Without those meditative pauses, Advent will pass you by, leaving you spiritually unprepared for Christmas.

Spend 5-10 minutes every day pondering the meaning of the Advent daily scripture readings (https://bible.usccb.org/readings); prayerfully ponder what God is teaching us about waiting, preparation, peace, hope, love, and joy. Have a Blessed Advent.

Please Note: The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, celebrated on Monday, December 8th this year is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be at 8:30am & 5:30pm at St. Clare and 12:10p and 7pm at Sacred Heart of Jesus.
