PASTOR'S COLUMN

On November 11, 1919, U.S. President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed an Armistice Day to be observed annually, to honor the armistice ending World War I – with major hostilities formally ending at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918. After WWII, President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed into law, that November 11 would be a day to honor all veterans, and so our country celebrates Veterans Day, which will be observed this week.

My father, uncles, and godfather are veterans of Vietnam. Both of my grandfathers were proud veterans of World War II, two of my great-grandfathers served in WWI, one of whom was honored as the oldest veteran of World War I in his hometown when he died.

Providence would have it that November 11 is also the liturgical feast day of a veteran saint, one of our Church's well-known and beloved soldier Saints, St. Martin of Tours, who is patron Saint of soldiers, along with St. Michael, St. George, St. Ignatius of Loyola, and St. Joan of Arc.

St. Martin of Tours was the son of a veteran, a soldier and officer in the Roman Army. Martin was actually forced to serve in the army against his will at the age of 15. But, while serving in the army, he came to understand sacrifice, honor, and loyalty as many soldiers do. It was as a young soldier that Martin was exposed to Christianity – newly legalized after 300 years of persecution. Soon, Martin began to desire baptism and was enrolled as a catechumen.

There is the famous story when, on a bitterly cold day, the young soldier met a poor man, almost naked, trembling in the cold and begging at the city gate. Martin had nothing but his weapons and his clothes. So he drew his sword, cut his cloak into two pieces, and gave one piece to the beggar. Some of the bystanders laughed at Martin's foolish act of charity. But that night, Martin had a vision of Jesus dressed in the cloak he had given to the beggar.

The Lord said,
"Martin, still a catechumen, has covered me with his garment."

"That which you did for the of my brethren you did for me." Martin, in sacrificing his cloak for a beggar, clothed Jesus.

St. Martin, like so many of our veterans who leave family and country to serve freedom, exemplify the charity to which we are called as Christians: self-sacrifice, trust in God, boundless generosity, willingness to be mocked for righteousness' sake.

Thank God for our veterans. May they be blessed for their service. May all veterans who suffer the physical and psychological effects of war be sustained and consoled.

May we prudently and wisely use and guard the freedoms for which our veterans labored and suffered for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

Saint Clare Community Outreach

From Fr. Estabrook & St. Clare Parish Finance Council

We begin by thanking you, our Saint Clare Parish family, for your ongoing support.

The financial report recently published in the bulletin, and submitted to the Diocese, is a clear indication that Saint Clare is in stable financial condition and for that reason, we are truly grateful and blessed.

It is vital that Saint Clare remain financially stable. This enables our Parish to carry out its mission: to celebrate our Faith and cultivate lives of service and stewardship.

This financial update is for your awareness. We believe that full transparency is crucial to increased understanding and accountability for all of us as Stewards of the parish.

For the fiscal year ended June 30, 2025, we are pleased to report that Saint Clare experienced a positive bottom line with a surplus of \$257,000. In addition, we have doubled our Fund Balance over the last 4 years.

We monitor financial performance through the lens of the following 3 categories:

- Parish Operations (including School Subsidy)
- Capital Improvements
- Special Bequests

Parish Operations:

This past fiscal year, Revenue (from Offertory, Fundraising, and School support) exceeded Operating Expenses resulting in a surplus of approximately \$53,000.

- It is important to note that “fundraising” is necessary to help with expenses. Your participation is most needed and most appreciated.

Capital Improvements:

Contributions to the Capital Improvement Fund this past fiscal year exceeded Expenditures by \$77,000, due to the intentional delay of planned projects until our new Pastor arrived.

- Our budget for the current fiscal year will utilize this surplus, and more, to fund the parking lot improvements (resurfaced driveway) and a new roof for the parish business office. These two projects alone amount to \$150,000 and are included in this year’s budget.

Special Bequests:

Outright gifts to Saint Clare, known as Special bequests, continue to be a significant source of revenue. However, this is not a predictable budget item, nor should we depend upon such gifts to operate the parish, but we are very grateful to those who remember St Clare in their giving.

Special bequests this year, plus earnings on Invested Funds, total approximately \$127,000.

Other noteworthy comments/concerns:

- School Support for Corpus Christi Academy (CCA) is a line item on our budget. CCA is a joint parish-school with Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish. CCA is not an independent school and therefore we have a vested interest in helping CCA to be successful and ultimately self-sufficient.
- We cannot stress enough the importance of **Online Giving**. Please make every effort to sign up via our Parish website if you haven’t already. This provides greater visibility and consistency when projecting revenue for planning and budgeting purposes each year.
- Offertory this year is down 15% vs. budget. Please consider increasing your giving in any way you can to help reverse this trend and help us to get back on track for this year’s budget.

Finally, be assured that we will continue to focus on strong fiscal management, weekly collections and fundraising events to maintain Saint Clare’s financial well-being.

Thank you for your continued support of the Church of Saint Clare and may God bless you and those you love.

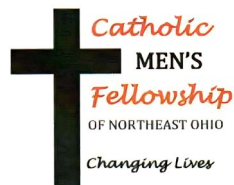

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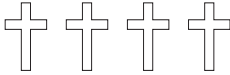
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
