PASTOR'S COLUMN

The Second Vatican Council was prophetic in many ways. The Council Fathers saw the growing materialism of the 20th century, the breaking down of families, increased number of divorces, decline in morals, and a devaluing of the sacred institution of marriage. In response to these cultural revolutions, the Council Fathers added the Feast of the Holy Family to the Liturgical Calendar to be celebrated the Sunday after Christmas, that we might celebrate the dignity of the family, as Our Savior Himself was born as a member of a family.

Pope Saint John Paul II, who was present as a bishop at the Second Vatican Council, never tired of reminding the Church that the future of humanity depends on marriage and the family. Saint John Paul wrote a wonderful document on the family called *Familiaris Consortio*, in which he wrote: "At a moment of history in which the family is the object of numerous forces that seek to destroy it or in some way to deform it... the Church perceives in a more urgent and compelling way her mission of proclaiming to all people the plan of God for marriage and the family."

And within this document, he gave four tasks for the family, so that families may become what God made them to be. One, the persons of the family must always seek to grow in communion with one another. Husbands and wives, parents and children must seek to deepen the bonds of love that join them. Two, St. John Paul called upon families to be at the service of life. He encouraged spouses to be generous in bringing new life into the world, as well as being diligent in raising those children in the faith. Three, he called upon families to contribute to society. Families should foster deep bonds of communion with other families, and work to ensure the protection of the family through political means.

Finally, he called upon families to share in the life and mission of the Church. Families should come together for the Sacraments, of course, but also join together for prayer, Scripture study, faith, charitable works and evangelization efforts.

May the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph strengthen and sanctify all of your families, aiding you in loving God and loving one another, for the glory of God and salvation of souls.



Godparent or Sponsor? The Sacrament of Confirmation is one of the three sacraments necessary for full initiation in the Church. Through Confirmation, God bestows many graces for the Christian Life and a strengthening in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation is necessary for serving as a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation sponsor and should also be received prior to Christian Marriage.

Catholics 14 years and older who have been baptized AND have received first Communion, but for whatever reason have not received Confirmation, are invited to attend a series of classes to prepare for the sacrament. Classes will be held in March.


