

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Back in 2021, Pope Francis declared that the fourth Sunday of July (next Sunday) is a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. This year, Pope Leo XIV has chosen as the theme for this year, a line from the book of Sirach: "Blessed are those who have not lost hope." (cf. 14:2)"

In his message for next Sunday, Pope Leo writes, "Sacred Scripture offers us many examples of men and women whom the Lord called late in life to play a part in His saving plan. We can think of Abraham and Sarah, who, advanced in years, found it hard to believe when God promised them a child. Their childlessness seemed to prevent them from any hope for the future... In the Bible, God repeatedly demonstrates His providential care by turning to people in their later years. This was the case not only with Abraham, Sarah, Zechariah and Elizabeth, but also with Moses, who was called to set his people free when he was already eighty years old. (cf. Ex 7:7) God thus teaches us that, in His eyes, old age is a time of blessing and grace, and that the elderly are, for Him, the first witnesses of hope...

The Book of Sirach calls blessed those who have not lost hope. (cf. 14:2) Perhaps, especially if our lives are long, we may be tempted to look not to the future but to the past. Yet, as Pope Francis wrote during his last hospitalization, "our bodies are weak, but even so, nothing can prevent us from loving, praying, giving ourselves, being there for one another, in faith, as shining signs of hope." (Angelus, 16 March 2025) "We possess a freedom that no difficulty can rob us of: it is the freedom to love and to pray. Everyone, always, can love and pray."

The Holy Father concludes his message, "Especially as we grow older, let us press forward with confidence in the Lord. May we be renewed each day by our encounter with Him in prayer and in Holy Mass. Let us lovingly pass on the faith we have lived for so many years, in our families and in our daily encounter with others. May we always praise God for His goodness, cultivate unity with our loved ones, open our hearts to those who are far away and, in particular, to all those in need. In this way, we will be signs of hope, whatever our age."

As we gather next Sunday for World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, let us take a moment to deepen our hope in the Lord and to consider how we are called to be signs of hope for others.

A <u>plenary indulgence</u> can be obtained by participating in Mass on this occasion or by visiting an elderly person who is alone or in difficulty (and by fulfilling the usual conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer, according to the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff).

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Are you a Martha or a Mary? How many times have we been presented with that question when we hear today's Gospel reading? At first ask, similar to many people, I would answer that I'm easily a Martha. I'm a perfectionist in many areas of my life, especially when it comes to my work or when I host dinner for friends and family. In those moments, I put a lot of pressure on myself to be the best I can be, to do the job well, and demonstrate the utmost hospitality. But as with Martha, too much focus on being "perfect" can cause worry and anxiety. But this year, hearing the story again, I realized something: There are times when I'm able to put those worries and anxieties aside and sit at the feet of Jesus just like Mary did, and I want to make that happen more often.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Although it has been several weeks since we celebrated the Sacred Triduum and we are back in Ordinary Time, the realization that I can be more like Mary than Martha has stayed with me. During the Triduum, we are asked by the Church to maintain a time of prayer, reverence, and, particularly on Holy Saturday, silence, as we reflect on Christ's death. This has always been the one time a year when I am able to find my "inner Mary" and sit at the feet of Christ. I thought the only way to do that was to completely shut myself off from everything, but that is not how God wants to be present in our lives. He wants to be with us always and seeks us where we are. With that realization, I learned that I can sit at his feet during my times of work or bustling as well. It can be as simple as listening to prayers on an app or praise and worship music while cooking dinner, or saying a prayer before I sit down to complete the next task at work and asking Jesus to be with me. This is a start to being more like Mary even during my busy periods. And by finding my inner "Mary," I find Jesus. So can you.

PRAY

Read through the Gospel again. Don't assume you have to stay stuck in the rhythm of being "Martha" when you know you long for a closer relationship with Jesus. Life is full of busyness and seemingly endless tasks, but being perfect will not bring calm. But inviting Jesus into those busy moments will. And when you do, Jesus will calm any anxieties you may have because you have "chosen the better part and it will not be taken from [you]."
