

PASTOR'S COLUMN

The month of September is dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Mary (the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is September 15th). During September (and also during Lent), it is especially fitting to offer the devotional prayer known as the Seven Sorrows of Mary. The devotion consists of praying seven Hail Marys while meditating on each of Our Lady's Seven Sorrows:

- 1) The Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:34-35)
- 2) The Flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-21)
- 3) The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41-50)
- 4) Mary Meets Jesus on the Way to Calvary (John 19:17)
- 5) Jesus Dies on the Cross (John 19:18-30)
- 6) Mary Receives Jesus (John 19:39-40)
- 7) Jesus is Placed in the Tomb (John 19:39-42)

In the 14th century, Our Lady revealed to St. Bridget of Sweden seven promises to those who honor her daily by meditating on her Seven Sorrows.

- 1) "I will grant peace to their families."
- 2) "They will be enlightened about the divine Mysteries."
- 3) "I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work."
- 4) "I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my divine Son or the sanctification of their souls."
- 5) "I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives."
- 6) "I will visibly help them at the moment of their death they will see the face of their Mother."
- 7) "I have obtained this grace from my divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and sorrows will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness, since all their sins will be forgiven and my Son will be their eternal consolation and joy."

It was reported by St. Alphonsus Ligouri that Our Lord Himself appeared to Blessed Veronica of Binasco, and said, "My daughter, tears shed for My Passion are dear to Me; but as I loved My Mother Mary with an immense love, the meditation on the torments which she endured at My death is even more agreeable to Me."

This is, of course, a "private revelation," but it is reasonable to believe that God who has given us Our Lady as a teacher and mother would want us to learn from her how to suffer, how to grieve, and how to unite our life to the sufferings of Jesus for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

THANK YOU for your donations!!

You have probably noticed!

We have recently completed repairs in our parking lot, primarily the entrance drive and some large portions of the north lot. This project came in at just under \$54,000. Thank you to all of our generous and dedicated parishioners for your support of our parish through contributions.

We have many other needed projects underway, specifically on the Sr. Lucy Center, which has not had any major building repairs or upgrades in over twenty years. It is showing its age.

- Completed repairs to the locking mechanisms of the north entry door cost just over \$1,100.
- The roof is in need of replacement at an estimated cost of between \$77,000 and \$83,000.
- Three air conditioning units will require replacement, one that cools the Harvest Room and two that cool the balance of the building. Estimates are pending.

The need for Capital Improvement funds is always present. There are plumbing projects pending for the school building that will require funds from Corpus Christi Academy and Saint Clare.

Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sir 3:17-18, 20, 28-29 | Heb 12:18-19, 22-24a | Lk 14:1, 7-14

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

There's a well-known story about an actor who was asked by an elderly priest to recite Psalm 23. The actor agreed only if the priest also recited the psalm. While the actor's delivery was met with esteem and applause, the priest's was met with raw emotion, stunned silence, and tears. The actor, smiling, said, "I may know the psalm, but the priest, he knows the Shepherd." I can't help but be reminded of this story when reading today's Gospel. Like the Pharisees, the actor represents the one who was the "center of attention" who was humbled whereas the priest, in his humble service to God, found himself exalted. That is where true humility lies, when our actions and our everyday lives are rooted in God first and not ourselves.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

As Jesus reminds us today, "Every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." Beyond telling us this truth, Jesus lived it. Scripture tells us that Jesus - the second Person of the Holy Trinity - "emptied himself, taking the form of a slave..." (Phil 2:7), and that he came not "to be served but to serve" (Mk 10:45). Each of us is invited to consider the ways we can imitate the same humble servantleadership which Jesus showed throughout his life. What does servant leadership look like, practically speaking? Some simple examples: At work, it might look like signing up to do those less desirable tasks that others would prefer to avoid. In our homes, it could look mean letting your children or spouse choose what's for dinner rather than asserting your own preferences over meal planning. In our relationships, it might mean allowing a friend to talk through their struggles without offering advice or sharing how you might have handled things differently. With the eyes of faith, each of us can see countless opportunities to practice the virtue of humility in daily life.

WITNESS

Like the priest in the story above who revealed God to the crowd in his recitation of Psalm 23, you have the opportunity to let God shine through in your life to others. Be a servant leader, seeking to glorify God rather than yourself. When you are humble you "will be exalted" and "repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."
