PASTOR'S COLUMN

This week, on Thursday evening, we will hold our first session of OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) for adults who wish to become full members of the Church. OCIA is comprised of several stages (Inquiry, Catechumenate, Purification & Illumination, Initiation, and Mystagogy), structured in such a way to reflect the ongoing nature of Christian formation and discipleship. *By the way, it is not too late to sign-up for OCIA or to encourage someone else to do so.*

The Period of Inquiry is a time to become acquainted with the Catholic Church and to hear the good news of salvation of Jesus Christ, our Savior. It is a time to look within one's life story and see connections to our needs for the Gospel. During this reflective process, one should ask questions, discern, and learn about a life of faith in Christ and the Catholic Church.

The following are a series of questions for reflection for those beginning OCIA, but I've included them here because reflecting on our faith reminds us that being Catholic is not just about routine, but about an ongoing relationship with Christ. Reflection deepens and enriches our faith, and prepares us to share that faith with others.

Questions About Faith and Life Experience: What experiences in my life have made me aware of God's presence or absence? When have I most clearly felt loved, forgiven, or guided by something beyond myself? What are the deepest hopes and longings I carry within my heart? What are the fears, struggles, or wounds I bring with me on this journey? How do I currently make sense of suffering, injustice, or hardship in my life?

Questions About Jesus Christ: Who is Jesus Christ to me right now? What do I already know about His teachings and example? What questions do I have about Jesus' identity as Son of God and Savior? How does the idea of Jesus offering salvation personally speak to me? What stories about Jesus in the Gospels have left the strongest impression on me?

Questions About the Church: What has been my past experience of the Catholic Church or other Christian communities? What draws me to explore Catholicism at this point in my life? What challenges or obstacles do I feel as I consider entering the Church? How do I understand the idea of the Church as a family of believers? What questions do I have about Catholic worship, sacraments, or teachings?

Questions About Discipleship and Living the Faith: What values or virtues do I see as most important for living a good and holy life? In what ways do I already try to live out love, forgiveness, and compassion? How do I imagine my life changing if I were to become Catholic? What gifts, talents, or experiences might I be able to share with the Church community? What do I most hope to discover in this journey of faith?

Please pray for those who will be going through OCIA this year: *Lord, open their hearts to Your Word, strengthen them with Your grace, and surround them with the love of the Church. May their questions be met with wisdom, their searching with truth, and their longing with the joy of Your presence. Guide them safely to the waters of Baptism and the table of the Eucharist, so that together we may grow as one body in Christ, who lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.*

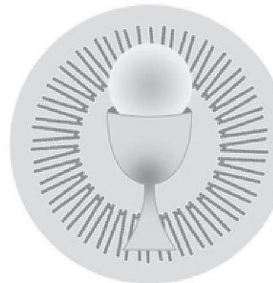
