

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Last week, I shared how the month of September is traditionally dedicated to the Sorrows of Mary, in part because the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is September 15th. The Church celebrates another Marian feast in September, and not a sorrowful one, but a very joyful one. This week on September 8 we celebrate the feast of The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary—Mary's birthday.

The liturgy for September 8 tells us: "Let us celebrate with joy the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, for from Her arose the sun of justice, Christ our God." It is strange that in a month dedicated to meditating upon Her sorrows, we also consider the joy of Her birth and the light which flows from Her.

Even amidst the sorrows of life, Christians, like Mary, are called to be a joyful people. Joy arises in us when we allow the light of faith and the love of God to fill our minds and hearts—when we, like Mary, ponder and recognize all that the "Almighty has done" (and is doing) for us.

Regarding the joy of Mary's birthday, Saint Andrew of Crete said "all creation sings with joy, exults, and participates in the joy of this day....for this is, in fact, the day on which the Creator of the world constructed His temple; today is the day on which by a stupendous project a creature becomes the preferred dwelling of the Creator."

When we are experiencing sorrow, it is important to not lose sight of God—His goodness, His love, His benefits, and His mighty deeds. Our human tendency in moments of grief or trial is to turn inward, to dwell on our pain, or even to question God's goodness. But the example of Mary teaches us that even in the midst of sorrow we are to hold fast to God's promises and trust in His providence—God's love is always at work, quietly but powerfully, bringing forth new life, new hope, and new joy. Through Faith begin to see beyond the veil of suffering to the presence of God Almighty.

So, as we honor Mary this week and throughout September—both in the joy of Her birth and in the sorrow of Her sufferings—we are reminded that Christian life is never only one or the other. Joy and sorrow, light and darkness, are interwoven in the pattern of our lives.

Like Mary, we must keep our eyes fixed on God and trust that great good can come from great suffering. May the birthday of our Blessed Mother renew in us a spirit of gratitude, joy, and hope in times of trial. And may She continue to guide us to Her Son, the true "sun of justice," who "shines on those who dwell in darkness and in the shadow of death, and guides our feet into the way of peace" for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

You have probably noticed!

We have recently completed repairs in our parking lot. Primarily the entrance drive and some large portions of the north lot. This project came in at just under \$54,000. Thank you to all of our generous and dedicated parishioners for your support of our parish through contributions.

We have many other needed projects underway, specifically on the Sr. Lucy Center, which has not had any major building repairs or upgrades in over twenty years. It is showing its age.

- Completed repairs to the locking mechanisms of the north entry door cost just over \$1,100.
- The roof is in need of replacement at an estimated cost of between \$77,000 and \$83,000.
- Three air conditioning units will require replacement, one that cools the Harvest Room and two that cool the balance of the building. Estimates are pending.

The need for Capital Improvement funds is always present. There are plumbing projects pending for the school building that will require funds from Corpus Christi Academy and Saint Clare.
