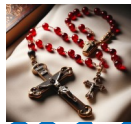

PASTOR'S COLUMN

We have entered once again into the Liturgical Season of Ordinary Time.

We often use the word “ordinary” to describe things that are unremarkable, commonplace, or dull. The word “ordinary” though, comes from the latin word *ordinalis*, which means ordered, orderly, regimented, steady, and consistent, like the ordinal numbers.

Just as Ordinary time is ordered, orderly, regimented, steady and consistent, so our own spiritual lives should take on the characteristics of this liturgical season: consistency in our daily prayer, regimented in our generosity and kindness, steady in our daily imitation of Jesus, and continuous in our openness to being challenged to growing in holiness. Discipline is needed to keep up the ordered, regimented spiritual practices that God uses to bring us spiritual growth.

The spiritual growth which we are to cultivate throughout Ordinary Time is symbolized by the liturgical color green. The green of Ordinary Time reminds us of that growth which is to occur in our souls—growth in our understanding and obedience to God’s will, growth in our use of the gifts of the spirit, growth in the fruits of the spirit, growth in prayer, faith, hope, and charity.

Green plants need sunshine, good roots, and nourishment for growth, and so do we. We need the sunshine of faith—study the faith, study the catechism, engage in Bible study. We need strong roots—rooted in God’s Word, reading the Bible regularly. And we need nourishment—prayer and the Sacraments of Holy Communion.

What does your daily spiritual regiment consist of? If you don’t have one, you need one.

Remember that parishioners have FREE ACCESS to [Formed.org](https://www.formed.org) containing a vast collection of video and audio lectures on various dimensions of our faith. [Instituteofcatholicculture.org](https://www.instituteofcatholicculture.org) is another excellent and free resource.

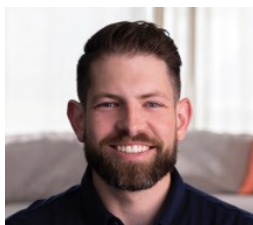

Through Confirmation, God bestows many graces for the Christian Life and a strengthening in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation is necessary for serving as a godparent for Baptism or Confirmation sponsor and should also be received prior to Christian Marriage.

Catholics 14 years and older who have been baptized AND have received first Communion, but for whatever reason have not received Confirmation, are invited to attend a series of classes to prepare for the sacrament. Classes will be held in March.

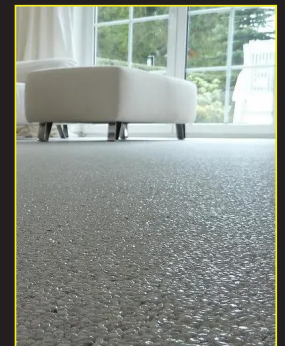
