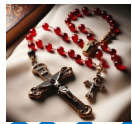

## PASTOR'S COLUMN

Ash Wednesday on February 18, 2026 marks the beginning of Lent. During Lent we show sorrow for our sins and commit to ongoing Christian conversion through increased prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

### Lenten Prayer

- Stations of the Cross: Fridays at 7:30pm (St. Clare) and 7pm (Sacred Heart of Jesus)
- Attending Daily Mass or reflecting on the daily Mass readings and Holy Week Liturgies
- Praying an additional devotional prayer like the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Litany of Humility, Morning & Evening Offering, the Liturgy of the Hours
- Making use of the Lenten resources on [Formed.org](http://Formed.org) such as "How to Lent," "The Spirituality of Lent," "Embracing Lent," "Healing in Lent," "Living Lent as a Family," "A Lent to Remember," "Restore: Lent with Sr. Miriam," "My Beloved Son: Meditations for Lent"
- Remember a different person every day in your personal prayers and offer your sufferings for them
- Make a Lenten Confession (Wednesday, March 4 at 5-8pm in addition to our normal schedule)

### Lenten Fasting

**ABSTINENCE**—Abstinence consists of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent.

**FASTING**—In addition to Abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On days of Fasting, only one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition

In addition to observing the laws of Abstinence and Fasting which are required by Church law, you might consider throughout the Lenten season:

- Abstaining from snacking between meals, desserts, fast-food, junk food, alcohol
- Eating only bread and water on Wednesdays or Fridays
- Abstaining from video games, social media, television, movies, internet videos

### Lenten Almsgiving

- Set aside your spare change every day for charity for the poor.
- Clean out your storage and donate items to charity.

- Commit to a daily act of kindness for a neighbor or co-worker
- Invite and drive a neighbor to Mass or Stations of the Cross

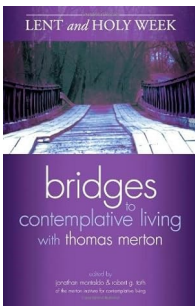

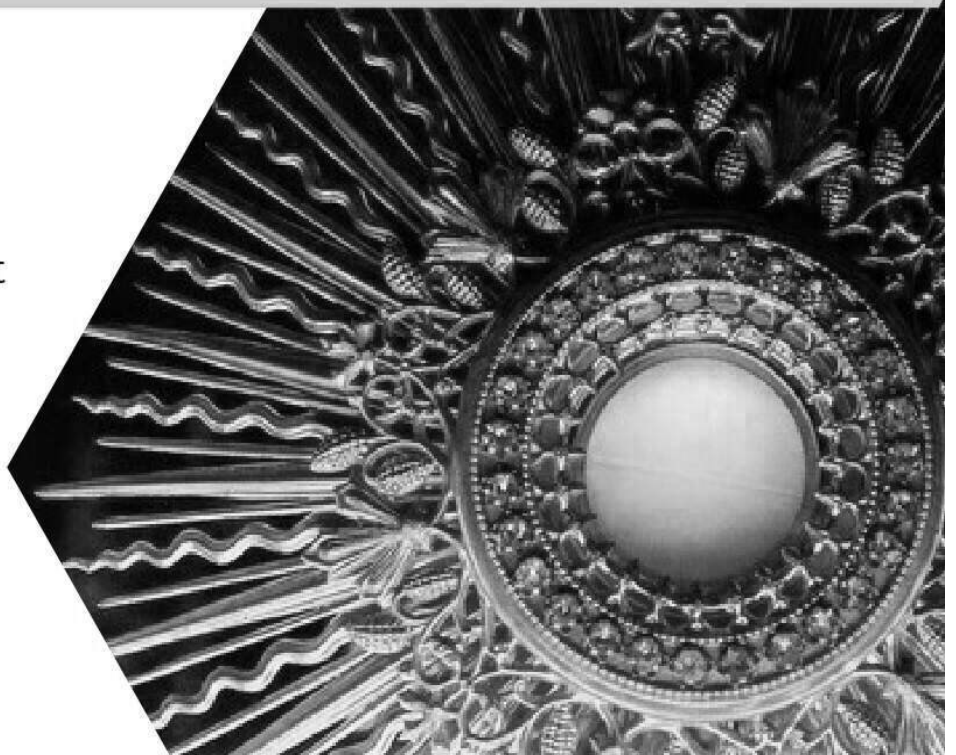

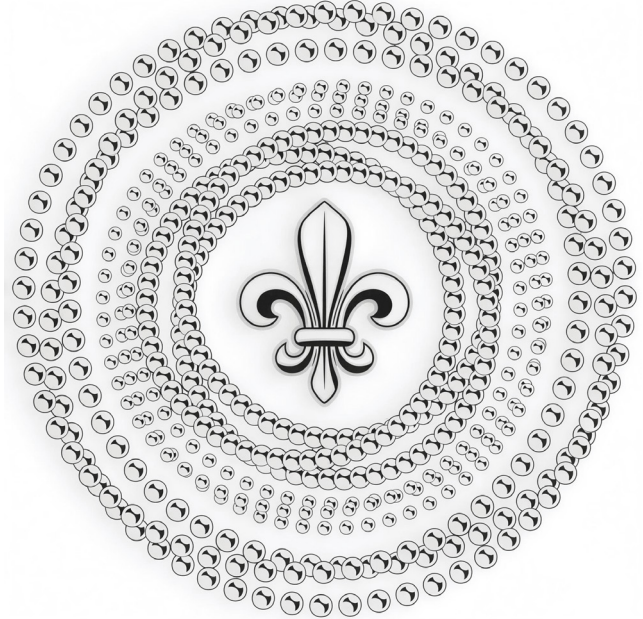

## Reaffirming the Faith

At Mass, we hear many readings from the Old Testament, but much of the Old Testament can seem a mystery. There are so many different books, and two do not directly mention God at all.

However, early Church Fathers and theologians discovered Christ and His revelation hidden, so to speak, within the words of the Old Testament.

As St. Augustine put it, the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New.

In this six-week program, we will look at examples from Genesis, Exodus, the Song of Songs, and other books to see how the early Church Fathers read the Old Testament to find Christ hidden there--for their benefit as well as ours. We will see how there are not really two Words of God—the Old and the New, but one: Christ.

We will meet at 1:00 pm on Fridays (after the 12:10 Mass and Novena) in Mary's Room at Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish, beginning February 20<sup>th</sup>.

Everyone is welcome. You need only bring your Bible and perhaps paper and pen if you wish to take notes.

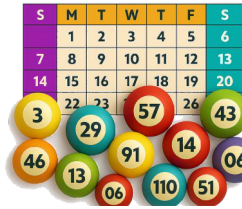
