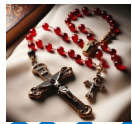

## PASTOR'S COLUMN

Temptation is one of the universal human experiences. Young, old, rich, poor, learned, unschooled—we have all at some point been tempted. Our first parents Adam and Eve experienced temptation, our Blessed Lord, as we hear in the Gospel for this first Lenten Sunday, experienced temptation.

We acknowledge that we are prone to temptation and ask God for help in facing temptations every time we pray the Lord's Prayer: "lead us not into temptation."

This petition asks God for a number of things. Firstly, we are asking God for the grace to discern between what leads to sin and what leads to grace. Secondly, we are asking God for the grace, in the form of moral strength, to choose what is good when faced with temptation. Thirdly, it is a petition for the grace of final perseverance—that we do not die outside the state of grace by which we would merit hell and everlasting separation from God.

We are not abandoned by God to our temptations. St. Paul writes, "No testing has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your strength, but with the temptation will also provide the way of escape, so that you may be able to endure it." (1 Cor 10:13) These words give us tremendous hope: "God will not let you be tempted beyond your strength." But this teaching also leads to the realization that sin is not inevitable, but results in our failure to turn to God for help.

In the Gospel, the Lord shows us that overcoming temptation is a battle. But the grace of Christ's victory over sin and temptation is available to us. "Such a battle and such a victory become possible only through prayer. It is by his prayer that Jesus vanquishes the tempter, both at the outset of his public mission and in the ultimate struggle of his agony." (CCC 2849)

During the season of Lent, we confront our temptations in union with the Lord, who confronted the Devil in the desert, trusting that by His grace, we can remain faithful to God. The nightly examination of conscience and frequent Sacramental Confession help us to identify those areas of our life in which we are tempted most and have fallen in the past.

May our Lenten penances rekindle our consciences and help us to remain on guard against temptation, to turn to the Lord for help in temptation, to ask His mercy when we've fallen to temptation, trusting that "He that shall persevere unto the end, he shall be saved (Matthew 10:22)," for the glory of God and salvation of souls.
