PASTOR'S COLUMN

In 1992, Pope St. John Paul II designated February 11 as World Day of the Sick on which we pray in a special way for those suffering from illness and those who care for them. The day coincides with the liturgical commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes in which we recall Our Lady appearing to the small child St. Bernadette and the erection of the shrine at Lourdes which has become a place of miracles and healing for millions of pilgrims.

Recently, the Roman Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has confirmed English and Spanish translation of a NEW Order of the Anointing of the Sick for liturgical use in the United States which will begin to be used February 11.

The new Order of the Anointing of the Sick is more faithful to the original Latin text. The Ritual Book contains the Order for 1) The Visitation and Communion of the Sick, 2) The Order of the Anointing of the Sick 3) Viaticum 4) The Order of Offering the Sacraments to a Sick Person Who is in Imminent Danger of Death 5) Confirmation in Danger of Death 6) The Order of Commendation of the Dying 7) Various Texts to be used in the Rites for the Sick

The Praenotanda to the Order is quite beautiful, shedding light upon the meaning of sickness and infirmity in the mystery of salvation: "The sufferings and sicknesses of human persons have always been considered among the greatest difficulties that disturb them. Yet those who profess the Christian faith, even if they feel and experience these difficulties, are, nevertheless, helped by the light of faith, so that they perceive more deeply the mystery of suffering and more strongly endure the sufferings themselves. For not only do they know from the words of Christ what sickness means and can be for their salvation and for the salvation of the world, but they are hardly unaware that those who are sick are loved by Christ, who visited and healed those with illnesses many times in his life. (no. 1)"

The Praenotanda then goes on to explain who can receive the Sacrament of the Sick: "In the Letter of James it is stated that the Anointing is to be administered to the sick in order to raise them up and save them. Therefore by every effort and diligence this Sacred Anointing is to be conferred on the faithful who because of sickness, mental illness, or age are seriously ill... This Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after having received the Anointing, or if, as the same sickness continues, there is a more serious relapse. Before a surgical procedure, the Sacred Anointing may be given to the sick as long as a serious illness is the reason for this procedure. The Sacred Anointing may be conferred on people of advanced age whose strength has been much weakened, even if a serious illness is not apparent. The Sacred Anointing should also be administered to children at that early age when they have attained such use of reason that they may be comforted

by this Sacrament. (nos. 8-12)

If you are in need of the Sacred Anointing, please call the parish office.

This Wednesday, February 11, please join in the work and care of the Church for the sick, by praying for them.







“Reading the Old Testament in the Light of Christ”

At Mass, we hear many readings from the Old Testament, but much of the Old Testament can seem a mystery. There are so many different books, and two do not directly mention God at all.

However, early Church Fathers and theologians discovered Christ and His revelation hidden, so to speak, within the words of the Old Testament.

As St. Augustine put it, the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New.

In this six week program we will look at examples from Genesis, Exodus, the Song of Songs, and other books to see how the early Church Fathers read the Old Testament to find Christ hidden there--for their benefit as well as ours. We will see how there are not really two Words of God—the Old and the New, but one: Christ.

Turning taxes into tuition with the Catholic Community Foundation

BE AN ANGEL!

Did you know the State of Ohio scholarship tax credit program makes a "no-net cost" donation possible that greatly benefits Corpus Christi Academy?

It's a Win-Win for:

- Donors to the Angel Scholarship Fund that may be eligible for a 1:1 state tax credit against their Ohio tax liability (up to \$750 for individuals or \$1,500 for married couples filing jointly, when both spouses contribute \$750); and
- Catholic school students K-12 that receive scholarships.

Two notes on the state tax credit:

1. The credit is applied against your Ohio tax liability. For clarification, your Ohio tax liability is the amount of taxes that you owe to the State of Ohio for the tax year (it is not based on the amount that you have to pay when you file your tax return). Therefore, even if you already anticipate receiving a refund due to overpayments during the year, your donation could increase the amount of your refund to the extent of your actual tax liability.
2. It is a nonrefundable credit, which means the amount of the state tax credit cannot exceed the amount of the Ohio tax liability.


