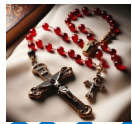

- If married, be in a marriage accepted by the Catholic Church

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Happy Laetare Sunday!

Laetare is the Latin word for “rejoice,” and this word is still found in the *introit* for the 4th Sunday of Lent:

“Laetare Jerusalem: et conventum facite omnes qui diligitis eam: gaudete cum laetitia, qui in tristitia fuistis: ut exsultetis, et satiemini ab uberibus consolationis vestrae.” (Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her.

Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.) The 4th Sunday of Lent is a reminder that Lenten mourning for sin makes way for Easter rejoicing.

We certainly rejoice with those who are preparing for Baptism, “which makes an end to sin and a new beginning of goodness (Rite of Baptism).” We will celebrate one Baptism at Saint Clare and one Baptism at Sacred Heart of Jesus at the Easter Vigil this year. Please continue to pray for Autumn (Sacred Heart) and James (Saint Clare) as they prepare for the Easter Sacraments. Consider joining us this year at 8:45 p.m. for the Easter Vigil, especially if you’ve never attended it before.

Today, we also recall the joy that comes from our Lenten penances. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving open the heart to be filled with spiritual joy that nothing on earth can give.

And what else compares to the feeling of making a good Confession. When guilt and shame are replaced with the knowledge of being forgiven by God—we are filled with certain joy.

In the Middle Ages, Laetare Sunday was also known as “Mothering Sunday.” This was appropriate for a number of reasons: the *introit* speaks of the “consoling breast” of Mother Church who nourishes us with the Sacraments of the Christian life; and prior to Vatican II, the scriptures for Laetare Sunday included Galatians 4:22-31, which speaks of Jerusalem (foreshadowing the Church) as “mother of all” who are baptized into Christ’s saving death.

On “Mothering Sunday,” Medieval Christians would make pilgrimage to their “Mother Church,” the church of their baptism. Gifts would be brought to the altar in gratitude for the new spiritual birth they received at that place.

Perhaps visit the main baptismal font today. “Rejoice” and say a special prayer of thanksgiving for your Baptism. Pray for all those who were baptized before you, and all who will be baptized in the future.

Joy is a net which draws souls to Christ. A joyful Christian soul is a magnetic soul which makes Christ known and loved in the world.

May each of us make a firm commitment to dispose ourselves to the joy of the Christian life, the joy which comes from God – who is our strength and our joy for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

*“Reading the Old
Testament in the Light
of Christ”*

At Mass, we hear many readings from the Old Testament, but much of the Old Testament can seem a mystery. There are so many different books, and two do not directly mention God at all.

However, Early Church Fathers and theologians discovered Christ and His revelation hidden, so to speak, within the words of the Old Testament.

As St. Augustine put it, the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New.

In this six-week program, we will look at examples from Genesis, Exodus, the Song of Songs, and other books to see how the Early Church Fathers read the Old Testament to find Christ hidden there--for their benefit as well as ours. We will see how there are not really two Words of God – the Old and the New, but one: Christ.

We will meet at 1:00 pm on Fridays (after the 12:10 Mass and Novena) in Mary’s Room at Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish.

Everyone is welcome. You need only bring your Bible and perhaps paper and pen if you wish to take notes.
