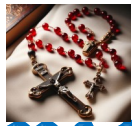

## PASTOR'S COLUMN

Lent and Sacramental Confession go hand-in-hand, for Lent is the great season of Repentance and Conversion.

This upcoming week, on Wednesday, March 4, every parish in the diocese will make available the Sacrament of Confession from 5pm to 8pm, including at Saint Clare and Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Regular Sacramental Confession is a great help for advancement in the spiritual life. Pope Pius XII (who went to the Sacrament of Confession every day) said, "For a constant and speedy advancement in the path of virtue, we highly recommend the pious practice of frequent Confession, introduced by the Church under the guidance of the Holy Spirit; for by this means we grow in a true knowledge of ourselves and in Christian humility, bad habits are uprooted, spiritual negligence and apathy are prevented, the conscience is purified and the will strengthened, salutary spiritual direction is obtained, and grace is increased by the efficacy of the sacrament itself (Mystici Corporis Christi)."

Given how efficacious Sacramental Confession is for the spiritual life, it might seem underwhelming that Canon Law only requires Catholics "to confess serious sins at least once a year (c. 989)." Even if we don't have serious sins, we do well to make a Sacramental Confession a few times a year, especially during the Lenten and Advent seasons.

Recall, "A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to celebrate Mass or receive the body of the Lord without previous sacramental confession unless there is a grave reason and there is no opportunity to confess (Code of Canon Law, no. 915)." This church law echoes the instruction of St. Paul in 1 Corinthians 11:28.

Regarding Confession, the Catechism instructs us that "the reception of this sacrament ought to be prepared for by an examination of conscience made in the light of the Word of God. The passages best suited to this can be found in the moral catechesis of the Gospels and the apostolic Letters, such as the Sermon on the Mount and the apostolic teachings (CCC 1454)." Feel free to take copies of the Examination of Conscience available at the church confessionals.

"Don't be afraid of Confession" as Pope Francis says, "the Lord is waiting to meet you there."

Addressing the National Catholic Youth Conference in October 2025, Pope Leo explained simply: "We experience this mercy of God in a special way in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In Confession, Jesus meets us through the priest. When we honestly confess our sins and accept our penance, the priest gives absolution and we know with certainty that we are forgiven. So, yes, it can be discouraging when we fall. But do not focus only on your sins. Look to Jesus. Trust His mercy and go to Him with confidence. He will always welcome you home."

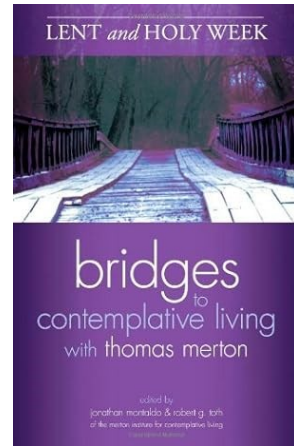

## Reaffirming the Faith

*"Reading the Old Testament in the Light of Christ"*

At Mass, we hear many readings from the Old Testament, but much of the Old Testament can seem a mystery. There are so many different books, and two do not directly mention God at all.

However, early Church Fathers and theologians discovered Christ and His revelation hidden, so to speak, within the words of the Old Testament.

As St. Augustine put it, the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New.

In this six-week program, we will look at examples from Genesis, Exodus, the Song of Songs, and other books to see how the early Church Fathers read the Old Testament to find Christ hidden there--for their benefit as well as ours. 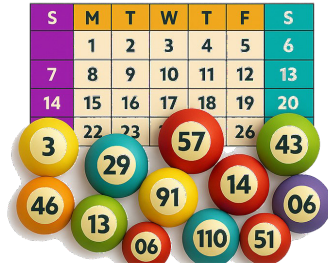
