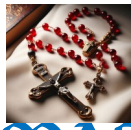

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Beginning with the fifth Sunday of Lent, the cross and statues in church are veiled with a purple cloth.

In the Roman Missal we find the instruction, "In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from [the fifth] Sunday [of Lent] may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil." You may consider veiling crucifixes and statues in your own home in solidarity with what we do in the church.

Sacred images that are normally visible to us are hidden from view. This creates a kind of fasting for the eyes, just as Lent is a season of fasting and self-denial in other ways. The Church in a sense is deprived of the visual consolation of the images, so that our attention is drawn more intensely to the mystery of Christ's Passion.

By hiding sacred images, we feel the gravity of Christ's approaching Passion, deepen our longing for Him, and prepare for the dramatic unveiling of the Cross on Good Friday and the joy of Easter.

During these final days of Lent, we should have a heightened sense of anticipation for the Paschal Mystery we celebrate during the Triduum. Whether it be veiling, or increased penances, time spent in quiet meditation, fasting from images on TV and the internet or praying of the Stations of the Cross, may these final days of Lent be marked by a deep desire to share in Christ's dying and rising.

Parish Life Questionnaire Update

Thank you to all who took the time to complete our recent parish survey. Parish Pastoral Council and I have begun to prayerfully analyze and reflect upon the results. We are hoping to present the results to the parish in a Parish Town Hall Meeting, but it will take some time for us to discern how best to present the material to the parish. So, the Town Hall Meeting would not be for another two or three months, I think.

Your responses revealed a deep love for our parish and strong support for the life of our parish community. Many expressed appreciation for the reverence of our Masses, our devotional life, and the fellowship we share. Your feedback also gives us helpful insight into areas where we can grow and strengthen parish life—such as welcoming new parishioners and holding more events for fellowship. Thank you again.

Old Testament in the
Light of Christ”*

At Mass, we hear many readings from the Old Testament, but much of the Old Testament can seem a mystery. There are so many different books, and two do not directly mention God at all.

However, early Church Fathers and theologians discovered Christ and His revelation hidden, so to speak, within the words of the Old Testament.

As St. Augustine put it, the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New.

In this six week program, we will look at examples from Genesis, Exodus, the Song of Songs, and other books to see how the early Church Fathers read the Old Testament to find Christ hidden there – for their benefit as well as ours. We will see how there are not really two Words of God – the Old and the New, but one: Christ.

We will meet at 1:00 pm on Fridays (after the 12:10 Mass and Novena) in Mary’s Room at Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish.

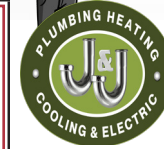

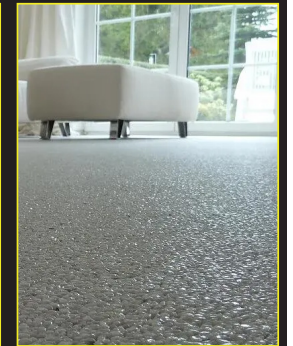
