PASTOR'S COLUMN

Holy Week is the last week in Lent, starting with Palm Sunday. During Holy Week, Christians reenact, relive, and share in the mystery of Christ's suffering, death and Resurrection. In many ways, the events of Holy Week tell us what our faith is all about.

The liturgies of Holy Week are rich beyond belief. Attend as many of them as possible with your families, for these are the High Holy Days of our Faith. They shape us and give expression to our faith like nothing else. If you simply cannot participate in the Holy Week liturgies, I urge you to take time every day this week, to read the scriptures for daily Mass, to ponder them deeply, Praying the Liturgy of the Hours (available for free using the "iBreviary" smartphone app) is a wonderful way to unite yourself with the Church at prayer during these Holy Days. I will lead Morning Prayer at St. Clare on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday at 9am.

On the Pious Use of Palms

Following Palm Sunday, you are encouraged to keep the blessed Palms in your homes or work places. The palms may be kept throughout the year as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the Messianic King, and in His Paschal Victory. Dried palms may be returned to the church in the weeks leading up to Lent next year or may be burned or buried.

Three Hours of Silence on Good Friday

On Good Friday, I recommend a total fast from diversionary use of technology from noon to 3pm. Turn off the smart phones, video games, televisions, radios/music systems. Spend some time on your knees with a crucifix in your hands. Pray the sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary. Read the Passion stories in the Gospels. Pray the Seven Penitential Psalms (Pss. 6, 32, 38, 51, 102, 130, and 143). Take a quiet walk outside. And come to Church for the 3:00 p.m. Liturgy of the Lord's Passion.

Holy Saturday Food Blessing

The blessing of the Easter Basket has been a cherished Catholic ritual for centuries. As we fasted from many of the fine and rich foods during Lent, this ritual thanks God for the celebrations with food and fellowship that Easter will bring.

There will be specific blessings for the Paschal lamb and other meats (like sausages), breads, eggs and other dairy products, wine, oil, candles, flowers, children's Easter baskets, and blessing for all other foods. Some cultures include in their baskets horseradish to symbolize the bitter herbs of the Passover, foretelling Christ's Passion; salt symbolizing God's grace which preserves us and improves the flavor of our lives, vinegar to represent the wine mixed with myrrh offered to Christ on the Cross,

Easter cake symbolizing the sweetness of eternal life, won for us through Christ's Resurrection; and butter, in the shape of the lamb.

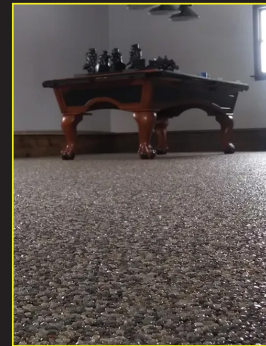
