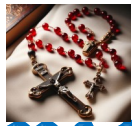

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Recently, a parishioner received a suspicious email from someone claiming to be me. She rightly called me and asked if I had sent the email. She was being targeted as part of a phishing scam, a type of cyberattack where attackers trick individuals into revealing sensitive information, such as passwords or credit card numbers, by pretending to be a trustworthy source. **No priest or member of the parish staff will ever email asking for gift cards or money or sensitive information.**

In this increasingly technological age, we have witnessed an alarming rise in online scams and fraudulent activities targeting individuals and organizations, including our beloved Catholic parishes. It is crucial for us to remain vigilant and informed to protect ourselves and our loved ones from falling victim to scams.

Scammers are resorting to various tactics, including email, text messages, and social media, to impersonate church staff and volunteers. They may use publicly available contact information, such as those listed on parish websites, to pose as trusted individuals and request cash, gift cards, or personal and financial information. Again, it's important to remember that **our priests and parish staff will never contact you via these channels to solicit such information.**

Be cautious of suspicious emails, texts, or social media messages, especially those that urge you to act urgently or offer something that seems too good to be true. Take a careful look at the sender's email address, message content, and formatting for any signs of inconsistency or deception. Hover over hyperlinks to verify their accuracy before clicking on them. If in doubt, refrain from clicking and instead contact the sender directly through trusted means to confirm the legitimacy of the communication. Delete or mark as "junk" any messages that raise suspicion, and refrain from disclosing personal or financial information to unknown or unverified sources.

It is sad that scammers will take advantage of the trusting nature of good Christians. However, the Lord said, "Be wise as serpents, and innocent as doves." We should be shrewd about the dangers of new technologies and in protecting ourselves in these troubling times.

Grant us, O Lord, the wisdom to use technology responsibly and ethically. Help us to discern what is beneficial and constructive, and to avoid that which leads us astray or causes harm to ourselves and others. May we always strive to use technology as a tool for good, promoting justice, compassion, and understanding in our interactions with others.

Protect us, O God, from the evils uses of technology — from the temptation to indulge in excessive screen time, from the allure of inappropriate content, and from the dangers of online predators and cyberbullying.

Shield our minds and hearts from the distractions and vices that can ensnare us in the digital realm.

Bless, O Lord, those who work in the field of technology — scientists, engineers, programmers, and innovators. Inspire them to use their gifts and talents for the service of humanity, promoting the common good and respecting the dignity of every person.

May God's grace and protection be with us as we navigate the challenges of the digital age, and may we remain steadfast in our commitment to safeguarding one another against harm. Amen.

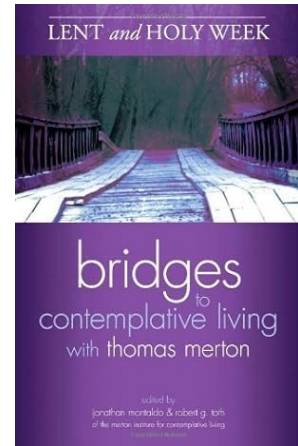

Reaffirming the Faith

A Continuing Program of Adult Faith Formation
*"Reading the Old Testament
in the Light of Christ"*

At Mass, we hear many readings from the Old Testament, but much of the Old Testament can seem a mystery. There are so many different books, and two do not directly mention God at all.

However, Early Church Fathers and theologians discovered Christ and His revelation hidden, so to speak, within the words of the Old Testament.

As St. Augustine put it, the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New.

In this six-week program, we will look at examples from Genesis, Exodus, the Song of Songs, and other books to see how the Early Church Fathers read the Old Testament to find Christ hidden there--for their benefit as well as ours. We will see how there are not really two Words of God—the Old and the New, but one: Christ.

We will meet at 1:00 p.m. on Fridays (after the 12:10 Mass and Novena) in Mary's Room at Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish.

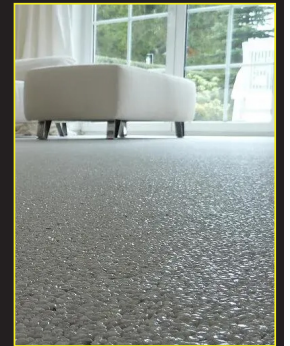
