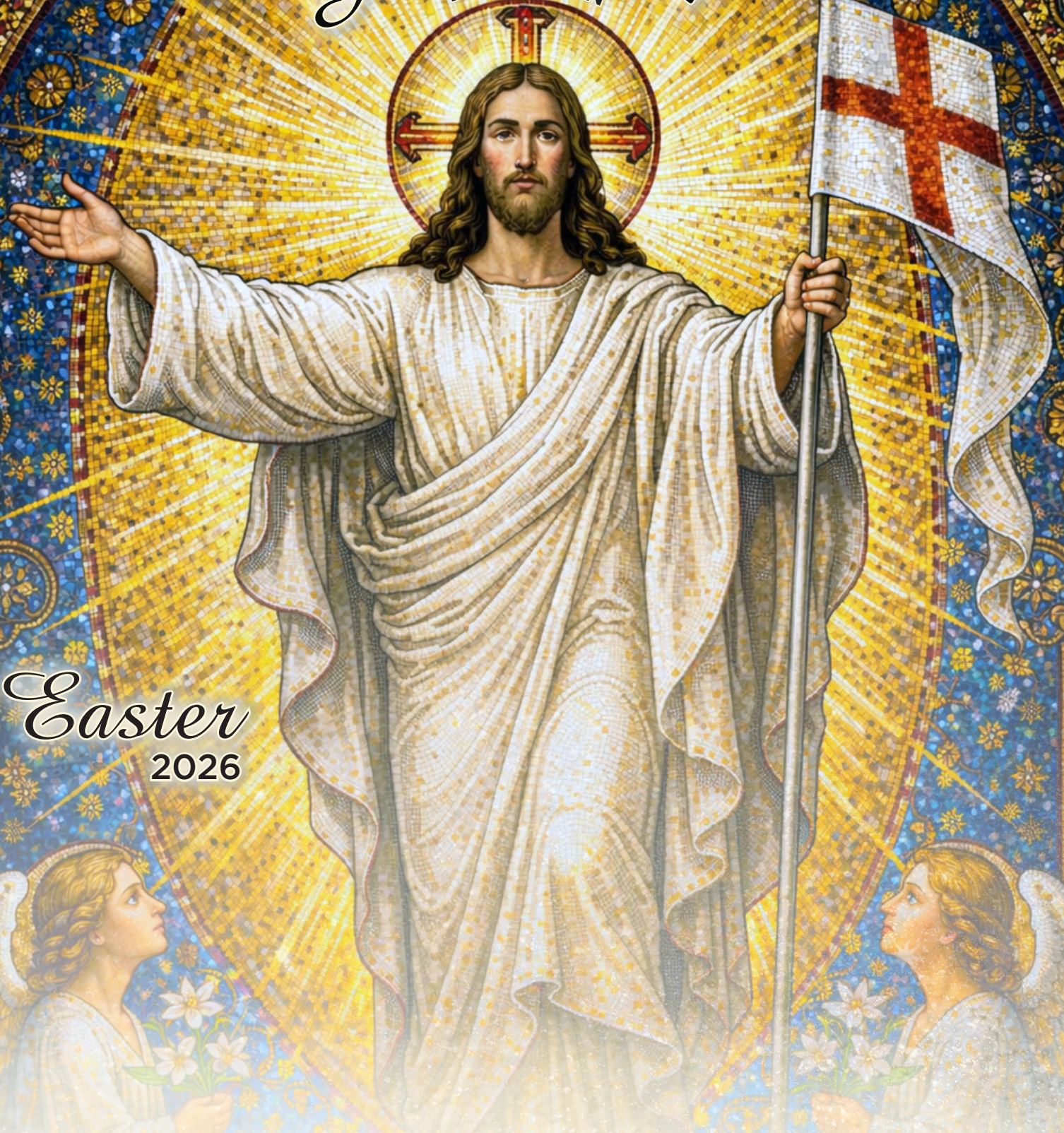

## PASTOR'S COLUMN

On this Fifth Sunday of Easter, we hear one of the most beloved and important declarations of Jesus in all the Scriptures: "I am the way, and the truth, and the life." Those words were first spoken to anxious disciples whose hearts were troubled. Jesus was preparing them for His Passion and Death, and they did not fully understand where He was going or what lay ahead. And yet, into that confusion and uncertainty, the Lord speaks clearly: *I am the way, and the truth, and the life.*

A few weeks ago, His Holiness, Pope Leo, made an apostolic journey to the North African countries of Algeria, Cameroon, Angola and Equatorial Guinea. On Tuesday, April 14, 2026, the pope visited the northeastern port city of Annaba, in Algeria, which developed from the ancient city of Hippo, home to St. Augustine, the founder of the Augustinians, of which Pope Leo XIV is a member.

At Mass at the Basilica of St. Augustine, His Holiness gave a beautiful homily reflecting upon the Lord's conversation with Nicodemus, which is read on weekdays during the second week of Easter.

Recently, Pope Leo reflected on the hope offered to us in Christ with these words: "When we ask ourselves how a future of justice, peace, harmony and salvation will be possible, we must remember that we are asking God the same question that Nicodemus asked: Can our story truly change? Can we truly start our lives over again? Yes! No matter how weighed down we are by pain or sin, the crucified One carries all these burdens with us and for us Each one of us can experience the freedom of new life that comes from faith in the Redeemer."

That message harmonizes beautifully with this Sunday's Gospel. Jesus does not merely show us a path forward as one teacher among many. He does not simply give advice, or point toward a distant destination. He Himself is the way. In a world so often marked by confusion, false promises, and discouragement, Christ reveals that the path to the Father, the truth about who we are, and the life for which we were made are all found in Him.

This also means that our lives are not trapped by the weight of the past. The question Nicodemus asked—Can a person begin again?—is answered in Christ. Yes, our story can change. Yes, a new future is possible. Yes, grace is stronger than sin, and hope is stronger than despair.

If we feel burdened by hardship, weakness, or uncertainty, the answer is not to look first within ourselves, as though we could save ourselves by sheer

effort. The answer is to look to Jesus Christ. He is the way when we feel lost, the truth when we are confused, and the life when we are weary.

May we follow Him with renewed confidence and place our hope in Him anew for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

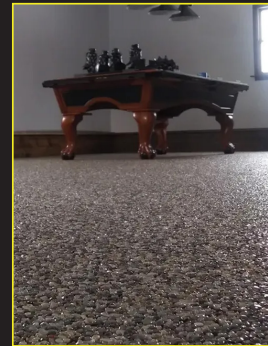
