PASTOR'S COLUMN

Parish Life Survey Summary

On May 21, 2026, I presented the results of our recent Parish Life Survey to a gathered group of parishioners. For those who were unable to attend, here is a summary of the key findings, reflections, and next steps:

I began the presentation reviewing the reasons for conducting the survey. I explained that when I was first assigned as pastor of Sacred Heart and St. Clare, one of my chief concerns was "how am I going to get to know the people of the parishes," their concerns and gifts especially since, my time, energy, and focus were going to be divided between the two parishes.

Since, Pastoral Council is tasked with assisting the pastor in receiving and evaluating feedback on existing activities and new initiatives within the parish, we developed a survey to do just that.

Participation: We received 214 responses — a strong level of participation that provides meaningful data. Respondents represented a good cross-section of tenure at the parish, from new members to long-time parishioners.

The survey highlighted several areas of health and vitality. **Worship and Sacramental Life:** By far the strongest area. The vast majority praised the prayerful and reverent celebration of weekend Masses, helpful homilies, and the overall liturgical experience. Opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration, daily Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, and other devotions were also highly valued. The Eucharist and reverent liturgy remain the heart of parish life and the source of greatest joy for most respondents. **Music Ministry:** Many expressed deep appreciation for the choir, organ, and congregational singing. **Leadership and Communication:** Most parishioners find the priests and staff approachable and responsive. The bulletin, website, and social media were generally well-regarded. **Stewardship and Facilities:** Strong agreement that our buildings and grounds are well maintained. Parishioners expressed trust in the responsible management of parish resources.

Areas for Growth, several themes emerged where parishioners desire continued attention:

Community & Hospitality: Many expressed a desire for stronger fellowship, more social events (picnics, coffee and donuts, family gatherings), better welcoming of new parishioners, and a deeper sense of belonging. Some noted this has weakened over time and would like to see it strengthened. **Adult Faith Formation:** There is clear hunger for more accessible opportunities, especially evening or family-friendly programs for working adults and younger families.

Outreach & Evangelization: While many opportunities to volunteer exist, some felt we could do more to reach inactive Catholics and better communicate our service to the wider community.

Youth and Young Families: Concern about engaging the next generation was noted.

Initial Priorities Based on the feedback, the pastor and Pastoral Council will focus on:

Strengthening parish community and belonging (hospitality ministry, fellowship events).
Expanding Adult Faith Formation.
Intentional outreach to young families and youth.

Your continued input is welcome. Feel free to reach out to me or members of Pastoral Council with feedback.

Thank you to all who completed the survey and to the Pastoral Council for their dedicated work. Your honest feedback is a true gift as we live out our parish mission together.

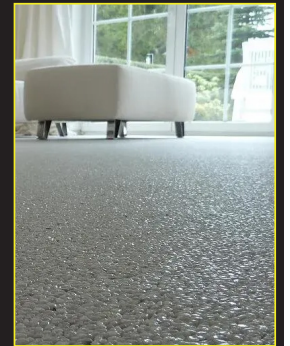
