PASTOR'S COLUMN

Why Are the Priests Chanting the Prayers More Often?

Following our Parish Life Survey Presentation on June 21, I met with Pastoral Council to follow up on feedback received from parishioners.

As I mentioned in my bulletin last week, there were areas where virtually all of the surveys agreed: That worship and sacramental life are vitally important to the parish, that our buildings and grounds are being well-maintained, that there is a desire for more community events and adult faith formation.

In some of the surveys, parishioners noted that our priests chant the prayers of the Mass—especially the **opening prayer (Collect)** and other presidential prayers—more frequently than our parish priests may have done in the past.

Please know that when the priests chant at Mass, it is not mere personal preference or innovation. The Church's liturgical documents are very clear: **When the Mass is celebrated giving full expression to its ritual elements, like Sunday is meant to be, the priest's prayers should be sung:** *"Care must be taken that the singing of the ministers and the people is not omitted in celebrations that are more solemn."* (Musicam Sacram, 7)

What many Catholics experienced for decades—Sunday Mass with the presidential prayers almost exclusively spoken – was common in practice, but chanting is good, holy, and called for by the Church's own liturgical documents.

Chanting prayer is deeply rooted in **Scripture**: The Psalms—the prayer book of Israel and of the Church—were **sung prayers**. St. Paul exhorts Christians to pray using **"psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs."** (Eph 5:19; Col 3:16) In the Book of Revelation, heavenly worship is **sung**, not spoken. So, when the priest chants the prayers of the Mass, he is praying in a way that mirrors **biblical worship** and points us toward **heavenly worship**.

The presidential (priest's) prayers are not private prayers. They are spoken **on behalf of the entire assembly**. And when the priest chants, the prayer becomes more clearly **public, solemn, and communal**; the text is **slowed down**, making it easier to hear and interiorize. The priest's role as one who **presides in the person of Christ** becomes clearer. Chant removes the prayer from casual speech and signals: *Something sacred is happening here.*

The saints consistently recognized sung prayer as a privileged path to God: **St. Augustine** famously said, *"He who sings prays twice,"* not because singing adds emotion, but because it unites **heart, mind, and body** in prayer. **St. Benedict**, in his Rule, assumed that the

liturgy—especially the psalms and prayers—would be chanted, and he warned monks never to rush or trivialize sacred prayer. **St. Thomas Aquinas** taught that sung prayer lifts the soul more easily toward contemplation and helps fix divine truth more firmly in the heart.

Chanting is not about performance; it is about **reverence, attentiveness, and interior participation**.

You might say **"but This Feels Different..."** That reaction is understandable. For many Catholics, spoken prayers became familiar, but **familiarity is not the same as normativity**. The Church has been gently calling clergy and parishes for decades to recover the sung liturgy envisioned by the Second Vatican Council.

Chanting the prayers is not meant to make Mass longer, more complicated, or less accessible. It is meant to make the Mass **more clearly what it already is**: the Church's solemn offering of praise to God. This is not about nostalgia, elitism, or "doing Mass a certain way." It is about **faithfulness**—to Scripture, to the Church's liturgical directives, and to the sacred mystery we celebrate.

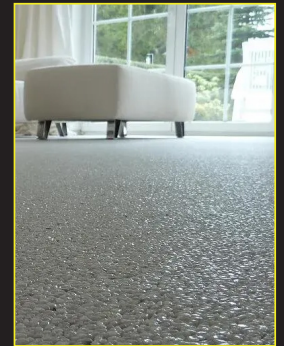
