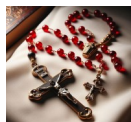

PASTOR'S COLUMN

The Orations for the Mass of Corpus Christi were composed at the request of Pope Urban IV by St. Thomas Aquinas in response to the powerful Eucharistic miracle the Pope himself witnessed in 1263, when the consecrated host, in the hands of a doubting priest, began to bleed.

Consider three lessons from the Collect Prayer for today's feast: *O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption.*

First, the Eucharist is a "memorial of Christ's passion." We celebrate the Eucharist over and over that we may rightly and gratefully remember the Lord's suffering and death which He endured for us and for our salvation. We remember how He gave His body and blood on the Cross, through unimaginable suffering, out of love for us.

Secondly, the Church prays to God to help us "revere" Christ's body and blood. By reverent words, gestures, and prayers, Catholics show our belief that bread and wine are truly changed into the Body and Blood of Jesus. We can never "revere" the Eucharist *enough*. Because the Eucharist is Jesus.

So we reverently kneel in Adoration before the blessed Sacrament. We reverently refrain from unneeded talking and noise in His presence. We reverently genuflect to the Eucharist. We reverently bow or genuflect or kneel prior to the reception of Holy Communion. We reverently receive the consecrated host with utmost care—taking care not to drop the host or smallest particle of the host. We reverently offer prayers and hymns during Mass and outside of Mass to Him Whom we adore. Our reverence is a sign of our love.

And thirdly, we ask God that we may "experience the fruits of redemption" through this Sacrament. The *Catechism* explains numerous fruits of the reception of Holy Communion: what material food produces in our bodily life, Holy Communion wonderfully achieves in our spiritual life (CCC 1392); Holy Communion separates us from sin (CCC 1393); as bodily nourishment restores lost strength, so the Eucharist strengthens our charity, which tends to be weakened in daily life (CCC 1394); by the same charity that it enkindles in us, the Eucharist preserves us from future mortal sins (CCC 1395); those who receive the Eucharist are united more closely to Christ and through it, Christ unites them to all the faithful in one body - the Church. (CCC 1396); the Eucharist commits us to the poor (CCC 1397).

The greatest of the fruits of Holy Communion, one might say, were explained by the Lord Himself: Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day (John 6:54). Whoever eats my

flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him (John 6:56).

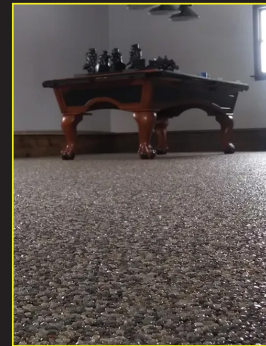
