PASTOR'S COLUMN

This week, on July 14, we honor a saint, native to these shores, Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. Kateri Tekakwitha was born at Auriesville, New York in 1656, near the place where the Jesuits St. Isaac Jogues and John de Brebeuf had been martyred—tomahawked by Iroquois warriors just nine years before.

Kateri's mother was an Algonquin who had been baptized, but she was taken captive by the Iroquois and given as a wife to the chief of the Mohawk tribe. Two children were born of this marriage, but only Kateri survived; her parents and her brother died in a smallpox epidemic when Kateri was 4 years old. Kateri's own face was permanently disfigured and her eyesight was impaired because of the disease.

New Jesuit missionaries were granted permission by the new chief of the Mohawks to minister to the Christians, most of them Iroquois captives like Kateri's mother. And since her mother was Catholic, Kateri was allowed to study the Catechism with the Jesuits. She was baptized on Easter Sunday at the age of 19.

At 23, she took a vow of virginity, consecrating herself to the Lord. But the celibate life was not held in high regard among the Mohawks, and Kateri was subject to constant abuse and insults. She was ridiculed for keeping holy the Sabbath and for praying the Rosary.

On the advice of a priest, she fled the abuse and walked two-hundred miles to an Indian Mission village near Montreal. There she devoted herself to prayer and works of charity and penance and her sanctity blossomed through a life of consecrated virginity. She is known as the Lily of the Mohawks.

Kateri herself said: *"I am not my own; I have given myself to Jesus. He must be my only love."* At her canonization in 2012, Pope Benedict said, "Her greatest wish was to know and to do what pleased God. She lived a life radiant with faith and purity. Kateri impresses us by the action of grace in her life despite the absence of external help..."

The journey to holiness walked by the saints often involves great challenges. St. Kateri had to strive for sanctity without the help of her own people. In fact, she faced open hostility from them.

St. Kateri is a model for all those who are rejected by their own because of their fidelity to Christ, and for all of us who strive to follow Christ amidst the hatred of the world. She reminds us to find strength in prayer, and maintain our focus on doing what is pleasing to God. St. Kateri Tekakwitha pray for us, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

3 Saints of Religious Freedom



Saint Miguel Pro
(1891-1927)

A Mexican Jesuit priest executed under the fiercely anti-Catholic regime of President Plutarco Elías Calles, Miguel Pro refused exile and continued ministering in secret. Arrested for his priesthood, he was condemned without trial.

As he walked to courtyard to face the firing squad, he blessed the soldiers, knelt in brief prayer, then rose to face them without a blindfold. Holding a crucifix and rosary, he stretched out his arms in the shape of the crucified Christ and cried,

“¡Viva Cristo Rey!”

“Long live Christ the King!”

When the firing squad failed to kill him, a soldier shot him at point-blank range.



Saint Maximilian Kolbe
(1894-1941)

Maximilian Kolbe was a Polish priest during the Second World War, known for his widely read spiritual writings and for sheltering thousands of Jews in his monastery after the German invasion. He was arrested and imprisoned in Auschwitz. When another prisoner was condemned to die, Kolbe offered his own life in exchange. Starved in a bunker, he remained prayerful and calm until his death. Kolbe died on August 14 1941 and was cremated on August 15, the feast day of the Assumption of Mary.

He is one of ten 20th century martyrs depicted in statues above the Great West Door of the Anglican Westminster Abbey in London.

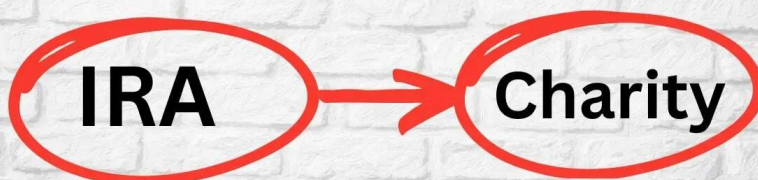


Saint Margaret Clitherow
(1556-1586)

Margaret, called *The Pearl of York*, lived in 16th century England under Queen Elizabeth I. The queen outlawed Catholic worship and punished dissent harshly. Jesuit priests were hunted and executed. Those who resisted the State Church faced substantial fines and loss of livelihood. Margaret sheltered priests in her home, risking her own life. Her compassion and courage drew the crown's attention. When captured, she refused to deny her faith or betray others.

Condemned for treason, while pregnant with her fourth child, she was crushed to death beneath heavy stones.

Qualified Charitable Distribution



If you are 70 ½ or older, you may be able to make a gift of a **qualified charitable distribution (QCD)** from an eligible IRA to Saint Clare, a 501(c)(3) charity. The distribution is **excluded from taxable income**, which can lower your overall tax liability. QCDs can also **count toward your RMD** if you are 73 or older, helping satisfy IRS withdrawal requirements without increasing taxable income

A Joyful and Heartfelt Thank-You!

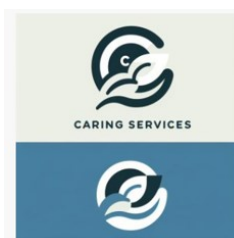
