PASTOR'S COLUMN

This week, on July 22, we celebrate the Feast of St. Mary Magdalene. It can be argued that Mary Magdalene is the second-most important woman in the New Testament. Throughout the four Gospels, she is named 14 times, more than most of the apostles. Yet, there is a lot of confusion about some of Mary Magdalene's biographical information.

Movies like *The Last Temptation of Christ* and *Jesus Christ Superstar* portray Mary of Magdala as having a romantic interest in Jesus. We won't even go into what Dan Brown, author of "The Davinci Code" has to say about her.

There is no scriptural evidence that Mary Magdalene was a prostitute. Nor is she the woman to have washed the feet of Jesus, that was Mary of Bethany in John's Gospel; St. Mark and Luke do tell us that the Lord had cast out of Mary Magdalene "seven demons." St. Luke also tells us that she helped provide for the needs of Jesus and His apostles out of her resources (Lk 8:3). And, unlike the majority of the apostles, she followed the Lord all the way to Calvary and stood at the foot of the cross with Jesus (Jn 19:25).

On Easter Sunday, she went to the tomb to weep for the Lord, but she found an empty tomb (John 20:1). The Risen Lord Jesus appeared to her (John 20:14-17). Faith and Love then impelled her to bring the news of the Resurrection to the apostles (John 20:18). For announcing the news of the Resurrection, saints and theologians from St. Thomas Aquinas to the modern popes have referred to St. Mary Magdalene as the "Apostle to the Apostles."

Now, of course, she wasn't one of the twelve apostles, and she is not regarded as a bishop at any point by the Church, but she is called "Apostle to the Apostles" because she is the first to encounter the risen Jesus, and she is sent by Him to bring news of His Resurrection to the other disciples. As the Opening Prayer for her Feast states: Christ "first entrusted to Mary Magdalene the joyful news of His Resurrection."

And that is the apostolic task of every member of the Church: to spread the good news about Jesus.

Whatever her past—whatever her life-course prior to becoming a disciple of Jesus—what she became is what matters most. She became a saint transformed by faith, hope, and love. Even the formerly demon-possessed can become saints and effective missionaries. She was delivered for a purpose, and so are we.

St. Anselm has a beautiful reflection on St. Mary Magdalene, in which he writes: St. Mary Magdalene, you came with springing tears to the spring of mercy, Christ; from him your burning thirst was abundantly refreshed; through him your sins were forgiven; by him your bitter sorrow was consoled. My dearest lady, well you know by your own life how a sinful soul can be reconciled with its creator, what counsel a soul in misery needs, what medicine will restore the sick to health... Draw me to him where I may wash away my sins; bring me to him who can slake my thirst; pour over me those waters that will make my dry places fresh."

May we, with the help of the Magdalene's prayers and example, be made worthy, like her, of the promises of Christ, for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

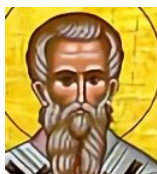

3 Saints of Religious Freedom



Saint Ignatius of Antioch
(35-108)

Ignatius of Antioch, also known as Ignatius

Theophorus, was the early Christian Patriarch of Antioch and martyr. Tradition holds he was appointed by Saint Peter and was a disciple of John the Apostle. Ignatius represented the Christian religion in transition from its Jewish origins to its assimilation in the Greco-Roman world. He laid the foundation for a hierarchical structure of the church and insistence on the real humanity of Christ.

Around 107 AD, under Emperor Trajan, he was arrested for his faith and taken to Rome, writing seven influential letters en route.

He was executed by wild beasts in the Colosseum and is venerated across Christian traditions.



Saint José Sánchez del Río
(1913 - 1928)

A young Mexican Cristero executed by soldiers of the Mexican Army after he refused to renounce his Catholic faith. His killing was widely understood to silence dissent and crush religious freedom during the Cristero War. Officials cut the soles of his feet, forced him to walk through the town to the cemetery and struck him repeatedly with a machete, causing multiple bloody wounds. He cried out in pain, but refused to yield. His captors said, "If you shout, 'Death to Christ the King,' we will spare your life."

José answered only with courage:

"Eu nunca vou ceder! Viva Cristo Rey!"

"I will never give in. Long live Christ the King!"



Jerzy Popiełuszko
(1947 - 1984)

Jerzy Popiełuszko was a Polish Roman Catholic

priest and chaplain of the Solidarity movement, renowned for his homilies defending human dignity, truth, and religious freedom under communist rule. His monthly Masses for the Homeland inspired resistance until his abduction and murder by secret police in 1984.

President Ronald Reagan called Popiełuszko "a champion of Christian values and a courageous spokesman for liberty."

In 2009 Pope Benedict XVI approved the beatification decree of Popiełuszko.

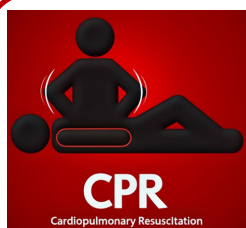

If you are 70 ½ or older, you may be able to make a gift of a **qualified charitable distribution (QCD)** from an eligible IRA to Saint Clare, a 501(c)(3) charity. The distribution is **excluded from taxable income**, which can lower your overall tax liability. QCDs can also **count toward your RMD** if you are 73 or older, helping satisfy IRS withdrawal requirements without increasing taxable income.

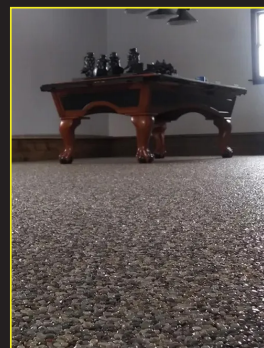
