July 4, 2026 is a day marked by Catholic prayers, patriotic reflections, and events that link American freedom to Christian faith, gratitude, and the legacy of Catholic patriots, while calling for moral responsibility and continued renewal in the Church and nation.



3 Patron Saints of Freedom



Saint Thomas More
(1478-1535)

As Chancellor of England under Henry VIII, St.

Thomas More refused to take the Oath of Supremacy, which would have required him to renounce his Catholic faith by declaring Henry the Supreme Head of the Church. As a result, More was indicted for treason. He famously said "I die the King's good servant but God's first."

More also stood firm in his commitment to the Church's teaching on marriage and the family – and found true freedom of soul when he paid the ultimate price.



Saint Lawrence
(225 – 258)

A 3rd-century deacon in Rome, St. Lawrence was in charge of the material goods of the Church. When he knew he would be arrested and persecuted, he gave away all the material goods of the Church to the poor, so that, when the Roman officials came, he could point to the people and say, "*These are the treasure of the Church.*" The officials were incensed. They condemned Lawrence to a slow and painful death, roasting him over a fire. But Lawrence found joy in suffering for the Lord, and in the good humor of true freedom his final request was, "*I am done on this side, turn me over!*"



Saint George
(d. 303)

Persecuted for his Christian faith under the reign of the Emperor

Diocletian, St. George endured some of the most horrible torture of his time. Originally a high-ranking officer in the Roman army, he was eventually beheaded in Palestine. His relentless perseverance led to his being named the patron saint of England as well as Russia, Georgia, Bosnia, and Portugal, to name a few.

Like so many saints who followed him, George put the Cross before the Crown, remaining a loyal Roman soldier even as he suffered the consequences of his faith under Roman law.

Education on The Main Tenets, Principles, and Themes of Catholic Social Teaching and Human Life Matters

The opening, eight-paragraph section of **Samaritanus Bonus** (the Vatican document on caring for persons in critical/terminal stages of life) is an important reminder of the Christian understanding of the human person—an understanding that often contradicts many assumptions present in today's predominant, "Western, individualist, consumerist, throwaway culture."

The document begins with a simple but profound observation: suffering inevitably raises questions about the meaning of life. Rather than dismissing these questions, the Church acknowledges them honestly. Human reason alone is often insufficient to fully grasp the mystery of suffering, illness, and death. Instead, the Christian faith invites us to view these realities through the lens of God's Revelation and the example of Jesus Christ.

At its heart, Section I is a reminder of the Catholic-Christian vision of the human person. We are more than biological beings or physical bodies. We are an integrated unity of body and soul, finite creatures destined for eternal communion with God. Human vulnerability and frailty are not defects to be overcome; they are part of the human condition itself. As the document explains, our shared vulnerability forms the basis for an "ethics of care"—a responsibility to accompany and care for one another, especially in moments of suffering.

This vision runs counter to the pervasive norms and values of our broader culture. Too often, our society



measures dignity by productivity, independence, health, or usefulness. The Christian tradition proposes something radically different: every person possesses an inherent and infinite dignity simply through existence. That dignity does not disappear when someone becomes elderly, disabled, chronically ill, or dependent upon others.

For this reason, the Church insists that our responsibility to care for others does not end when restoration to physical health and well-being are no longer possible. In this opening section, readers are reminded that while we must sometimes accept the reality that a person's condition is incurable, we must never abandon the person. The sick, aged, and vulnerable deserve care that addresses not only physical needs, but also psychological, social, spiritual, and relational needs. It is in Section I where we first encounter the memorable line, "To cure if possible, always to care."

Ultimately, you'll find the first part of *Samaritanus Bonus* encouraging you to develop a "contemplative gaze" in relation to the sick, the aged, or the vulnerable—the ability to see every human life as a unique and unrepeatable gift. Such a vision helps us resist the temptation to view people as burdens, problems, or projects. Instead, we are called to recognize Christ in the suffering person before us and, like the Good Samaritan, accept responsibility for our neighbor with compassion, presence, and hope.

"My Yoke Is Easy"

In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to take His yoke and learn from Him. A yoke joins two walkers so the weight is shared, never carried alone. That's the heart of His promise. Jesus doesn't remove life's burdens; He carries them with us.

Our image of Christ walking beside a younger disciple captures this beautifully. When we match our steps to His gentleness and humility, the load shifts.

What once felt heavy becomes lighter, steadier, more hopeful.

This week, notice where you feel worn down or stretched thin. In those very places, Jesus quietly says, "*Walk with Me.*"

His strength becomes our rest, and His presence turns burden into peace.

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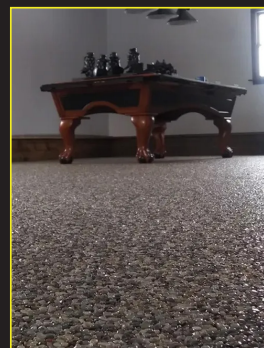
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
