PASTOR'S COLUMN

August 1 is the feast day of the great doctor of the Church, Saint Alphonsus Ligouri who wrote extensively on the virtues. He writes: "All holiness and perfection of soul lies in our love for Jesus Christ, who is our Redeemer and our supreme good. It is part of the love of God to acquire and to nurture all the virtues which make a man perfect."

The individual Christian is to aim at becoming as holy and perfect as we can, as our Lord Jesus Himself taught on the Sermon on the Mount: "Be perfect, as your heavenly father is perfect!" (Matthew 5:48)

At first, this command may seem overwhelming. We are well aware of our sins, weaknesses, and imperfections. Yet Jesus does not command the impossible. With the help of God, we are to seek to conform our thoughts, choices, habits, and desires toward perfection—toward God, who is love.

Growth in holiness and love, as St. Alphonsus explains, especially through the acquisition of virtue. A virtue is a stable habit or disposition that enables us to do what is good more readily, consistently, and joyfully. A single generous act is good, but the virtue of generosity makes generosity part of our character. A single patient response is commendable, but the virtue of patience enables us to bear difficulties without quickly surrendering to anger, resentment, or discouragement.

Virtue does not develop accidentally. Just as physical strength grows through repeated exercise, virtue grows through repeated acts performed with God's grace. We become more patient by choosing patience in difficult moments. We become more courageous by doing what is right despite fear. We grow in humility by listening, admitting our faults, and giving credit to others. We deepen in charity by deliberately seeking the good of those around us, especially when love requires sacrifice.

The Christian Life involves more than merely avoiding serious sin, but intentional effort to grow in virtue – to "nurture all the virtues."

To nurture the virtues, St. Alphonsus recommended intentional focus on a particular virtue each month: January: faith; February: Hope; March: Love of God; April: Love of Neighbor; May: Poverty; June: Purity of Heart; July: Obedience; August: Meekness and Humility of Heart; September: Mortification; October: Reconciliation and Silence; November: Prayer; and December: Self-Abnegation and Love of the Cross."

St. Alphonsus even recommended keeping a notebook or journal—an account of your failures and successes in practicing those virtues. A spiritual journal can assist you in practicing accountability for the growth in the virtues you seek to attain. For example, during the month of August, keep an account of your daily success and failures in practicing "Meekness and Humility of Heart." Additionally, reflect upon what it means for you to grow in the virtue by asking questions like:

- How do I show my gratitude to God for the good things in life? Where am I most-tempted to take personal credit rather than giving credit to God? What dimensions of life do I find most difficult to surrender to God's will? From whom do I find it difficult to receive advice, instruction, or correction, and why? What unnoticed, ordinary, or menial acts of service am I reluctant to perform?
- What situations most easily disturb my peace or provoke anger within me? How does anger affect my judgment, speech, facial expressions, or treatment of others? What grievances do I continue to rehearse after the occasion has passed? What happens within me when I cannot control a situation or another person's behavior? How does my tone or attitude change when I

feel contradicted, criticized or disrespected? How am I to learn from the Lord who is "meek and humble of heart?"

The pursuit of virtue is not a project of self-improvement undertaken for our own glory. It is our response to the love of Jesus Christ. The more we love Him, the more we desire to resemble Him. And the more the virtues of Christ take root within us, the more clearly His goodness becomes visible through our lives, for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.
