PASTOR'S COLUMN

A few months ago, on May 15, 2026, the Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, published the first Encyclical of his pontificate titled *Magnifica Humanitas* (which you can read for free on the Vatican website).

Firstly, what is an Encyclical? An encyclical is one of the highest forms of papal teaching. It is a letter from the pope addressed to the entire Church and, in this case, to "all men and women of goodwill." When a pope writes an encyclical on a particular topic, he is not simply offering his casual opinion. He is speaking as the universal shepherd, drawing on centuries of Scripture, Tradition, and the lived experience of the Church to address how the Gospel speaks to the concrete lives of people.

Magnifica Humanitas is Pope Leo's first encyclical. And the concrete issue he wished to address was protecting and promoting the human person in the age of emerging Artificial Intelligence.

Artificial Intelligence is not a distant, futuristic concept. It is already deciding who gets a bank loan, who gets called for a job interview, what news you see, what internet content you and your children encounter, even who lives and who dies on battlefields. It is being used by your government, your doctors, lawyers, journalists, and even by those in the Church.

At the forefront of the Encyclical, Pope Leo draws upon two images from Scripture. The first is the Tower of Babel (Genesis 11:1-9)—a story of humanity using its collective power and technology to build something grand, but without God. The result is not unity, but fragmentation—not progress, but confusion.

The second image is that of Nehemiah rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem (cf. Neh 2–6), a different kind of building project undertaken by God's people, not driven by pride or profit, but by prayer, shared responsibility, listening, and a genuine concern for every member of the community.

Pope Leo XIV says the emergence of AI entails a choice between these two biblical lessons. We can use AI to build Babel, a world of algorithmic control, digital exploitation, growing inequality, and the slow erosion of what makes us human. Or we can use it to "rebuild Jerusalem," putting technology at the service of human dignity, the common good, and genuine solidarity. The Encyclical is not anti-technology. It never says AI is evil. What it says is that technology is never neutral. It takes on the character of the people who build it, fund it, and use it. And so the question is not whether we will use AI, we already are. The question is what kind of people we will be while using it.

Pope Leo concludes the encyclical invoking Mary: "In the humble fidelity of daily life, even the era of AI can become a time in which the Holy Spirit brings about the civilization of love in our lives. Indeed, the Lord continues to make all things new and offers every era the possibility of becoming part of salvation history in the light of the Incarnation. I entrust our desire to the Mother of Christ, to the Woman of the Magnificat, that she may guide our steps through this time of change and preserve in each of us true faith in the Gospel, so that we may bear witness to the grandeur of humanity, in which God has made his dwelling."

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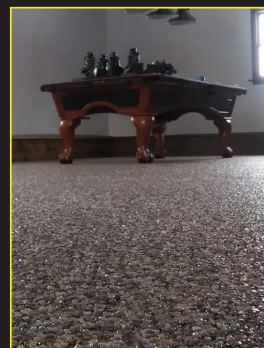
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
