PASTOR'S COLUMN

The month of September is dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Mary (the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is September 15th). During September (and also during Lent), it is especially fitting to offer the devotional prayer known as the Seven Sorrows of Mary. The devotion consists of praying seven Hail Mary's while meditating on each of Our Lady's Seven Sorrows:

- 1) The Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:34-35)
- 2) The Flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-21)
- 3) The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41-50)
- 4) Mary Meets Jesus on the Way to Calvary (John 19:17)
- 5) Jesus Dies on the Cross (John 19:18-30)
- 6) Mary Receives Jesus (John 19:39-40)
- 7) Jesus is Placed in the Tomb (John 19:39-42)

In the 14th century, Our Lady revealed to St. Bridget of Sweden seven promises to those who honor her daily by meditating on her seven sorrows.

- 1) "I will grant peace to their families."
- 2) "They will be enlightened about the divine Mysteries."
- 3) "I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work."
- 4) "I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of My divine Son or the sanctification of their souls."
- 5) "I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives."
- 6) "I will visibly help them at the moment of their death — they will see the face of their Mother."
- 7) "I have obtained this grace from My divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to My tears and sorrows will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness, since all their sins will be forgiven and My Son will be their eternal consolation and joy."

It was reported by St. Alphonsus Ligouri that Our Lord Himself appeared to Blessed Veronica of Binasco, and said, "My daughter, tears shed for My Passion are dear to Me; but as I loved My Mother Mary with an immense love, the meditation on the torments which She endured at My death is even more agreeable to Me."

From the Cross, the Lord Himself, commanded us, "Behold your mother." Meditation on the Seven Sorrows fulfills the Lord's command, "Behold your mother," because it teaches us to look upon Mary not sentimentally or abstractly, but as she truly stands in the mystery of Christ: the Mother who suffers with her Son, believes through darkness, and accompanies the Church in every trial. This powerful devotion trains the eyes of the soul to

behold Mary's heart: obedient, pierced, steadfast, compassionate, and entirely united to Christ. She experienced exile, loss, helplessness, the death of her beloved Son, and silence, and draws near to us, when we experience the same.

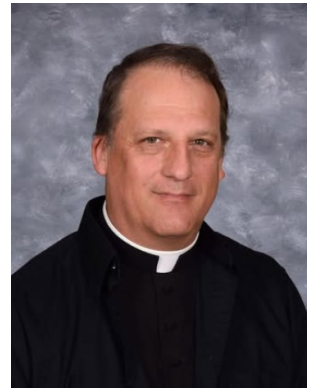

The documentary **“American Martyr: The Stanley Rother Story,”** narrated by Martin Sheen, tells the powerful story of Father Stanley Rother, an Oklahoma priest who served the Indigenous Tz’utujil people in Guatemala. As civil war violence escalated, Father Stan was placed on a hit list but insisted that **“the shepherd cannot run,”** returning to his parish even though he knew it placed his life at risk. He was killed in 1981 for remaining with his people.

Pope Francis declared him a martyr in 2016, and he became the first U.S.-born priest to be beatified at a ceremony attended by thousands in 2017.

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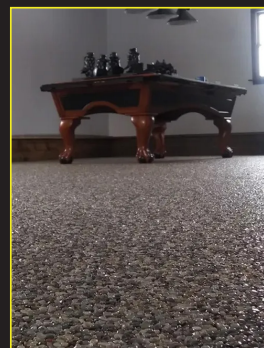
