**A MESSAGE FROM FR. KLASINSKI
AND THE
PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL**

The Church of Saint Clare Parish Finance Council Mid-year Update—February 3/4, 2024

As promised, we are providing an update for the mid-point of our fiscal year ending June 30, 2024. Being fully transparent with you is crucial to increased understanding and accountability for all of us as stewards of the Church of Saint Clare.

I am pleased to report that through December 31, the Church of Saint Clare realized a modest surplus of approximately \$30,000. This is primarily attributable to your generosity at Christmas with a collection of \$50,000 and Special Bequests of approximately \$34,000 for which we are very grateful.

However, Council remains concerned about the second half of our fiscal year, January to June 2024, as our offertory collections continue to run behind budget. As we have reported, our parish has normal operating expenses of approximately \$17,000 per week for which we rely on our offertory collections. In addition, our parish also had certain annual expenses such as the priests' pension and the school subsidy, which combined, are estimated at \$60,000.

Consequently, our challenge is to avoid a deficit the next six months. The Diocesan Finance Office has made it VERY clear to all parishes that annual deficits are unacceptable. With your help, we can meet this challenge!

What will it take for us to achieve consistent financial performance?

Increased giving of 15 to 20 percent on a consistent basis. For example, that means weekly giving of \$20 per week would need to be \$24 per week, or \$500 per month would need to be \$600 per month.

Further, we cannot stress enough the importance of "online giving." This provides a far greater positive impact for consistent giving.

Be assured, we will continue to focus on strict expense management, increased giving and fundraising events to maintain financial "well-being" for the Church of Saint Clare.

Shortly after Easter, a more formal Offertory Enhancement Appeal is scheduled to occur.

It is vital that our parish remains financially stable to fully carry out the Mission of the Church of Saint Clare, which is "to Celebrate our Faith and Cultivate Lives of Service and Stewardship."

Thank you again for your continued support of the Church of Saint Clare and may God bless you!

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

The leper in today’s Gospel was not only severely ill, but he was also barred from practicing his faith. Because he was considered unclean, he could not enter the temple to worship. It is no wonder he did everything in his power to find Jesus and beg him for healing. And heal him Jesus did, both body and soul. According to commentary on this passage from the USCCB, “In curing the leper, Jesus assumes that the priests will reinstate the cured man into the religious community.” It seems to me that this Gospel is about faith, and about love. The leper had great faith that Jesus could heal him, and the great love of Jesus for this man moved Jesus to go against mosaic law by touching and healing him. When we read the Scriptures we are reminded over and over again how much God loves us. Let us allow this knowledge to sink into our hearts and change us. When we begin to reflect God’s love to those around us, we will find that our lives are filled with his peace. Give it a try: Love as Jesus loves.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The Gospel is about Jesus’ love, and it’s also about great faith. Faith is a theological virtue that involves believing in God and everything he has said and revealed. It is a free gift from God, and with the help of his grace, faith is the foundation of our personal and communal relationship with our Triune God. As God’s children baptized into the Body of Christ, we can root everything we do in faith so that all of our actions point to God and to building his kingdom. How do we do this? It’s hard to say it much better than Paul does in his letter to the Corinthians today: “Whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God.”

ACCOMPANY How do we love as Jesus loves? Accompany another. Perhaps there is someone in our lives with whom we can walk alongside on their journey of faith. It need not be intimidating; as Christian disciples we already possess the tools we need to accompany: listen, love, share and pray.
