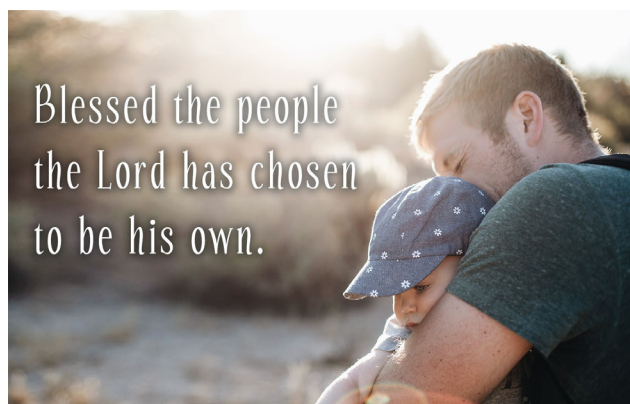

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



*Our Lord bless thee and keep thee.

Blessing of Saint Clare*

The city of Assisi is physically and spiritually anchored by the Basilicas of Saint Francis and Saint Clare that magnificently soar into the sky at the west and east boundaries of the medieval fortified town. Francis and Clare were baptized at the same font in the Cathedral of San Ruffino. Francis was of the merchant class and spent his young adulthood as a knight errant in service of warring princes of Italy. Without any purpose in life, he was known as the city clown till the day he stopped long enough to hear the Crucifix in the ruined Church of San Damiano say to him: *Go Francis, and repair my house which, as you see, is falling into ruin.* The ruined church of San Damiano and the Catholic Church of the thirteenth century were repaired in no small measure by the itinerant preaching of the Franciscan Friars who gathered around the now transformed “Clown for Christ.”

Among many in Assisi attracted to Brother Francis was a young woman of striking beauty and noble birth by the name of Clare Offreduccio. Abandoning family, title and wealth, she slipped away to San Damiano and there collaborated with Francis to found what would become the contemplative Order of the Poor Clares (locally on Rocky River Drive and Euclid Avenue). I was privileged to offer Mass at the altar of the Saint Clare Basilica above which hangs the very Crucifix which spoke to Saint Francis. Beneath the altar is the tomb of Saint Clare where her body is in open view. (She was not much taller and certainly as slight as our parish church statue at the southeast shrine!) In my twenty-five years as pastor, I have puzzled as to what to say about Clare that speaks to our contemporary lives. None of us are of noble birth nor are we contemplatives. I spent five days in Assisi. I walked each morning through the breathless beauty of the Spoleto valley and came to better appreciate how Clare and Francis saw God in His creation, to praise and admire Him. In the afternoons, I would sit in the very rooms where Clare lived and died, before the Blessed Sacrament, and marvel at the Gift we have received in Christ.

Saint Clare died on August 11, 1253. The Pope hurried from Rome to personally provide the Last Sacraments and preside at her funeral. Saint Clare was canonized in 1255 – just two years after her death – and August 11 remains her feast day and is now the patronal feast of our parish. The Bull of Canonization begins in this way: *Brilliant because of her clear merits, shining in Heaven because of her clear glory, and on earth resplendent because of her sublime miracles ... To the glory of Christ. Amen!*

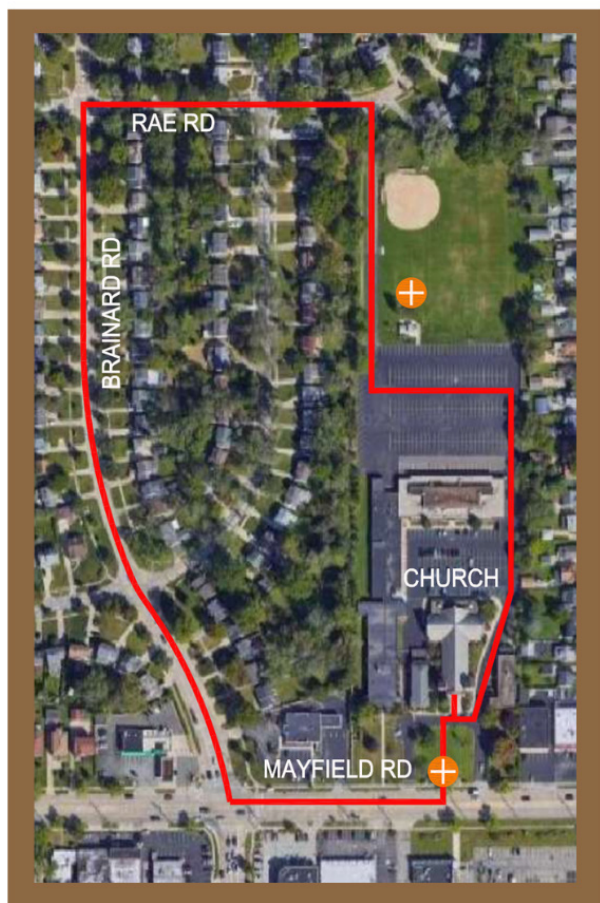

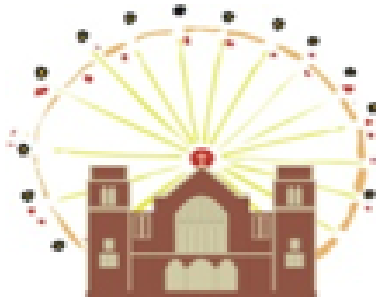

In today's chaotic world Jesus calls us to be holy. But what does that mean exactly and is holiness achievable for us, given the concerning state of the world? I remember the first time I moved: A suitcase or two fit in the back of my dad's lime-green Delta 88 as my parents dropped me off at college. Four years later, it took that plus a large black chest. The next move required a U-Haul; then came marriage, a family, and a moving van. I may not store my treasure in barns like the man in last week's readings, but at times it feels that way. It's natural to accumulate more "stuff" as we grow older. But in today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that we won't take any of it with us when we make the move to our final destination. Rather than focus on our possessions, he encourages us to be vigilant, remain faithful, and live in service to others. In doing so, we will store up "an inexhaustible treasure in heaven that no thief can reach nor moth destroy. For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

**GO EVANGELIZE**

**PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT**

Few things throw me into a panic like unexpected company. I have taken to at least cleaning the kitchen counter and bathrooms before going on a trip so the house will look presentable should something befall me and others have to come in with food or aid! We truly do not know the day or the hour, and the Gospel today encourages us to apply a little of that spring cleaning to our souls. Each day presents a new opportunity to prepare for the day we meet Jesus. If we've been out of touch, we can get reacquainted through prayer. If we feel weighed down by things we've done or said, we can bring them to the Lord through the sacrament of reconciliation. We can witness to our belief in God's promise of eternal life by putting people above possessions and supporting one another as we seek to live as Jesus taught us.

**ACTION** Today's psalm response is: "Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own." Count your blessings and write a few of them down, giving thanks to God for each of them.

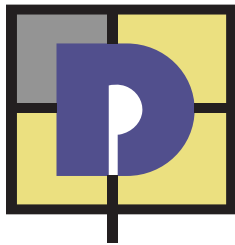

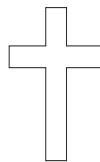
