St Monica is the patron saint of mothers. Pray for God to bless your mother.

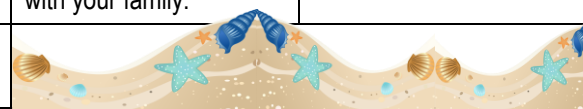
28 Feast of St. Augustine
