The Church of Saint Clare is committed to the safety and health of all our parishioners. In Person faith formation plans to meet in compliance with CDC, ODH, American Academy of Pediatrics, CCBH and Diocesan guidelines as follows due to the increased number of COVID-19:

- The building and classrooms will be cleaned and disinfected before and after PSR
- Masks are required for all who are in the building and classrooms
- All who enter the building are to sanitize their hands
- Hands must be sanitized upon entry to each classroom
- Space will be allotted and marked to maintain social distancing of all
- Classrooms will be well ventilated
- Health is to be monitored at home children, catechists and staff are to stay home when sick!
- If anyone in your household develops symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19, they should immediately isolate and call Cuyahoga County Board of Health at 216-201-2000.

The situation regarding COVID-19 will continued to be monitored and reviewed as things change. We will be in communication if at any time there is a need to change these guidelines.

All families must acknowledge their commitment to being respectful regarding the health and safety of all those attending faith formation events:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Wear a mask or face covering while in crowded public places or if people who don't live with you
 must visit your home.
- Avoid unnecessary gatherings with people who don't live in your home.
- Avoid sharing food, drinks, or utensils.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Sing the Happy Birthday song twice to help know when it has been 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use alcoholbased hand sanitizers that contain at least 60% alcohol.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and wash your hands immediately. If you do not have a tissue, use your sleeve, not your hands, to cover cough & sneezes.
 If you are experiencing cough or congestion, consider staying home & seeking medical care
- Regularly clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends cleaning of frequently touched surfaces with household cleaners and EPA-registered disinfectants that are appropriate for the surface, following label instructions. A simple bleach solution may also be used.
- Commitment to adhere to these guidelines as a Healthy, Holy & Happy Family Safety Agreement.
